Project description: English Paper Piecing Made Easy.

We will stitch a Lucy Boston block;

One block can be used to make a pillow, and three blocks will create a table runner.

A brand new way to EPP...

Self-stick templates are the magic.

No basting/gluing, whip-stitching, or pulling papers.

Simply straight stitch by machine or hand.

Move and reuse the template until it no longer sticks.

We will learn how to focus cut fabric, cut exact repeats, and then straight stitch by machine or hand. Plus lots of tips and tricks.

Pattern: English Paper Piecing Made Easy (Lucy Boston) Package

Fabric requirements:

4 coordinating 1/2 yards with motifs small enough to fit in the 1" honeycomb.

A 1/2 yard solid for the background

Sewing supplies:

1. Sewing machine with power cord, foot control, 1/4" foot
2. Neutral thread 50 wt. gray, beige, or white
3. Add A Quarter 6" ruler
4. Small to medium cutting mat
5. Rotary cutter
6. Purple Thang is helpful, but not necessary
7. Lightbox, if you have one, is not necessary
8. Elmer's School Glue with a small tip, if you have one

Preparation prior to class:

Bring your supplies. We will do everything in class.
