Project description: Join Lisa to cut and assemble this beautiful and easy quilt that has just one block to hone those already learned skills! *You will not get the entire quilt complete during class time. This is a working, hands-on technique and tips class. *

Pattern: Constance by Robin Pickens (required)

Creative Grids Stripology Ruler XL *optional but helpful OR Creative Grids Stripology Square Ruler *optional but helpful

Fabric requirements:

Choose four LARGE print MAIN fabrics that work together well; , then choose two COORDINATING color fabrics that work well with that LARGE-print MAIN color-way and ultimately all go together. You will need a total of eight fabrics with a background fabric for just the front. * Backing can be purchased later, but if you wish, choose your **binding** at the same time as the top fabrics. See pattern back for the amount of each fabric needed, depending on the size of the quilt you are making.

Sewing supplies:

- 1. Sewing machine with $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot; don't forget your **foot pedal** and **electrical cord**
- 2. Neutral thread
- 3. Rotary cutter, mat, general ruler 6 ½" x 24 ½"
- 4. pins, pin cushion, small scissors (snips)
- 5. iron and ironing pad * optional so you don't have to wait in line *

Preparation prior to class: Please have your pattern and fabrics chosen/purchased prior to class so all classmates can start at the same time. If you need to borrow a machine, please let QB know so we can have one reserved for you.
