Project description: A sophisticated looking quilt made using only 4 different blocks. A chance to play with colors to achieve an ombre effect, go for a rainbow, or make it in two colors. The class will focus on a Throw sized quilt, but the pattern includes other sizes and Judy will help you with any size. Kits available.

Pattern: Interwoven

Fabric requirements: For a throw sized quilt (for other sizes, consult the pattern)

Hombre:

Colors – 3/8 yard of 11 fabrics in shades of the same color

Background – 3 ½ Yards

Rainbow:

Colors – 3/8 yard of 11 fabrics in the rainbow spectrum

Background – 3/8 yards of 11 fabrics that are lighter versions of each of the colored fabrics.

2 – Color:

Dark – 3 ½ yards

Light – 3 ½ yards

Sewing supplies:

1. Sewing machine with power cord/foot control/basic foot and accessories.
2. Basic sewing notions such as pins, clips, thread snips.
3. Rotary mat, cutter and ruler.
4. Temporary fabric marker.
5. Thread for piecing.
6. Numbered pins helpful.

Preparation prior to class:

Cut all fabric into 1 ½” x WOF strips.
