

# Mini Charm Bag

## SUPPLY LIST

**Dates:** TUESDAY, JULY 9<sup>TH</sup> | 10A-1P

**Project description:** This quilted bag finishes 7 ½” wide x 6” tall x 2 ¾” deep. You’ll learn simple techniques like inserting a zipper and creating box corners.

**Pattern:** Nantucket Mini-Charm Bag by Camille Roskelley – Download [HERE](#) and bring to class!

### Fabric requirements:

- 1 mini-charm pack
- 1 fat quarter for lining
- 5” x 5” piece of coordinating solid for the bag tabs
- 12”x18” piece of fusible fleece, batting, or foam stabilizer (Soft & Stable preferred)
- Coordinating nylon zipper at least 11”

*Optional:* ¾” D ring set

*Optional:* zipper pull charm

### Sewing supplies:

1. Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, and:
  - a. ¼” foot, edgestitch/topstitch foot, zipper foot – if you’re not sure what’s what, just bring all your feet!
  - b. Walking foot for quilting
2. 505 spray for basting
3. Thread snips, fabric scissors
4. Removable fabric marker
5. Coordinating thread
6. Stiletto or turning tool is optional but helpful
7. Pins
8. Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat

### Preparation prior to class:

If you’re using scraps from your stash, precut your fabric so you have **40 - 2 ½” squares**.
