# **Mini Charm Bag**

## **SUPPLY LIST**

Dates: TUESDAY, JULY 9<sup>TH</sup> | 10A-1P

**Project description**: This quilted bag finishes  $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide x 6" tall x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " deep. You'll learn simple techniques like inserting a zipper and creating box corners.

## Fabric requirements:

1 mini-charm pack

1 fat quarter for lining

5" x 5" piece of coordinating solid for the bag tabs

12"x18" piece of fusible fleece, batting, or foam stabilizer (Soft & Stable preferred) Coordinating nylon zipper at least 11"

Optional: 3/4" D ring set Optional: zipper pull charm

#### Sewing supplies:

- 1. Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, and:
  - a. ½" foot, edgestitch/topstitch foot, zipper foot if you're not sure what's what, just bring all your feet!
  - b. Walking foot for quilting
- 2. 505 spray for basting
- 3. Thread snips, fabric scissors
- 4. Removable fabric marker
- 5. Coordinating thread
- 6. Stiletto or turning tool is optional but helpful
- 7. Pins
- 8. Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat

#### Preparation prior to class:

If you're using scraps from your stash, precut your fabric so you have 40 - 2 ½" squares.
