Project description: Decorate your holiday home with an elegant machine embroidered wall hanging that features Gothic letters adorned with laurel boughs. Learn how to get perfect results with machine applique in embroidery. We will stitch a few blocks in class, then gain useful tips on how to complete your project at home.

Pattern: Peace on Earth by Janine Babich Designs

Fabric requirements:

- ¾ yd. background fabric
- ½ yd. print for border & binding
- ¼ yd. fabric for lettering
- ⅛ yd. accent (for inner border)
- ½ yd. for backing and sleeve
- ¾ yd. fusible fleece
- Tearaway stabilizer for eight 5" x 7" hoopings

Sewing supplies:

1. Embroidery machine with designs loaded, a 5" x 7" hoop (a magnetic hoop works wonderfully), embroidery foot and 3-4 pre-wound bobbins (white)
2. 5-6 thread colors to coordinate with fabric (background quilting, letter outline, letter highlight, leaves, branch, berries)
3. Rotary cutter, 18" ruler and mat (we have some available for use in class)
4. Sharp small scissors for trimming your applique pieces.
5. ¼" foot, seam guide (optional but helpful), straight pins for assembly



Preparation prior to class:

1. Load designs onto your machine (if you aren't sure how, receive help in class)
2. Print instructions for reference in class.
3. We will cut and prepare our fabrics in class.

We will take a break for lunch. There is a microwave and refrigerator available for use.
