**Project description:** Storm Front is a dramatic quilt that is based on the Storm at Sea Block. It is constructed using Deb Tucker's 180 Studio Diamond Recs Ruler, Deb Tucker's 180 Studio Corner Beam Tool and Creative Grids - Square 8" Trim Tool. Learn how to use these tools to achieve precision piecing with perfect points. The finished quilt measures 90" x 90". Kits are available featuring Tim Holz's fabric for easy fabric selection!

Required Pattern: Storm Front

Required Rulers: Studio 180 Diamond Rects Tool and Corner Beam rulers plus Creative

Grids Ruler: Square on Square 8" trim tool

### Fabric requirements (kits available):

Fabric 1 – 5-5/8 yd. (contrasting background)

Fabric 2 - 1-5/8 yd.

Fabric 3 – 2 yd. (includes binding)

Fabric 4 - 2 - 1/2 yd.

Fabric 5 - 1-1/2 yd.

Fabric 6 – 1/4 yd.

8 yd. 45" fabric or 3 yd. 108" wide backing

### Sewing supplies:

- 1. Sewing machine with power cord/foot control/quarter inch foot
- 2. Rotary mat, rotary cutter with sharp blade, the 3 required rulers, plus an 18" ruler
- 3. Neutral thread

#### Preparation prior to class:

We will organize and cut the fabric as needed in class. You will need to sew at home between sessions in order to complete your quilt top over the course of this class.
