## **Studio Tunic**

## **Project description:**

The Studio Tunic is a pinafore-style pullover tunic. You do not need to know clothes construction. However, it is required that you *know how to sew and you are familiar with your sewing machine.* The tunic is a loose-fitting fun and easy pattern where you will learn how to make French Seams, apply shaped facings, and construct patch pockets.

Pattern: Required: The Studio Tunic by Sew Liberated

**Fabric requirements**: Refer to pattern for fabric and interfacing type and yardages. Mid weight woven fabrics like linen, linen blends or denim fabric is preferred.

## **Sewing Supplies:**

- 1. Sewing machine, foot pedal, electric cord, standard foot for straight and zig zag stitching, top stitch foot is optional. This is made with 1/2" seam allowance so do not bring your 1/4" foot.
- 2. Rotary cutter or scissors for cutting out fabric. Pins or weights (4 soup cans are great!) for holding the pattern on the fabric.
- 3. Thread to match your fabric. Bobbin thread can match or be neutral.
- 4. Pins or clips for sewing. Fabric marking pen.
- 5. Thread snips, fabric shears. Small 6" ruler or measuring tape.

## Preparation prior to class:

- Purchase pattern, fabric, interfacing, matching thread.
- Read through the pattern to familiarize yourself with steps.
- Use a measuring tape and measure your bust and hip area. Have those measurements ready so we can determine sizing.
- Make sure you are familiar with your sewing machine and how to use it.
- WASH AND IRON YOUR FABRIC.
