Tiling Scene – Pick Your Favorite SUPPLY LIST

Project description: Tiling scenes take embroidery into the art world. There are so many beautiful options! Choose your personal favorite from OESD. By the end of class, you will understand the basics of putting it all together. You'll complete a tile in class, then learn how to stitch them together with precision. Continue to stitch your blocks out at home to complete your project.

Required Pattern: Choose your own Tiling Scene Embroidery design.

Print off your instruction booklet for yardage requirements and thread sequences.

Fabric requirements:

The amount of fabric depends on the size of the Tiling Scene you select. Determine your fabric requirements – background, backing and binding SF101 – get the same amount needed for the background

Sewing supplies:

- 1. Embroidery machine with power cord and the smallest hoop to fit tile block
- 2. Embroidery thread to match designs
- 3. Heavy tear away stabilizer
- 4. Rotary mat, cutter, ruler (or use the ones we have in the classroom)
- 5. Prewound bobbins white polyester and one with dark thread
- 6. One spool water soluble thread

Preparation prior to class:

Print off your entire instruction booklet for your tiling scene. You will need to check off each thread color as you progress through your blocks. The instructions will also tell you how much background and backing fabric you will need.

I like to use SF101 ironed to the back of my background fabric to help stabilize it. Do <u>NOT</u> cut your background fabric into smaller pieces. We will prep and cut our background fabric in class to use our fabric a little more efficiently.
