Project description: Using a foundation and simple strip piecing, you will create this wonderful accent piece for your home. With a little homework in between, we will finish our tuffets in class!

Pattern: 18" Tuffet Foundation Pattern* and Tuffet Hardware kit (includes button, batting, foam, cording, tee-nuts, round plywood base, bottom cover and feet) <u>*with Fabric Foundation included</u>

Fabric requirements:

- $\ensuremath{^{\prime\prime}}$ yd. of 8 different fabrics plus one 6" square for covered button
- 1 Fat Quarter for underside of Tuffet

Sewing supplies for Class 1:

- 1. Sewing machine with power cord, foot control, and 1/4" foot
- 2. Neutral thread for piecing Tuffet top (fill 3 bobbins with the same thread)
- 3. Rotary cutter, mat & ruler
- 4. Add-A-Quarter PLUS

Additional supplies for Class 2:

- 1. Tuffet Source Hardware Kit
- 2. Permanent sharpie marker
- 3. 12" upholstery needle
- 4. Large-eye tapestry needle for cording
- 5. Heavy weight thread to apply cording
- 6. 72" lightweight cording
- 7. Hammer and staple gun (we will have one available to share)
- 8. Sharp 5" embroidery/craft scissors

Preparation prior to class:

- 1. Cut out the wedges on the OUTSIDE LINES of your preprinted muslin.
- 2. Cut each fabric into 4 2'' strips and cut on the fold to yield 8 pieces $2'' \times 20''$
- 3. If you start with a jelly roll, you do not need to cut down your strips.
