Today, The Collective are very excited to share that we have recently been awarded the opportunity to further extend our retail platform with a space in Kenneth Kaunda International Airport (KKIA), Lusaka, Zambia. This is a unique opportunity to showcase our artisans' products to every visitor flying in and out of Zambia, and one we have been pushing for since the opening of the new Airport. However, the stipulated opening by June 2023 by the Zambia Airport Corporation Limited is a very quick turnaround and presents us with a financial challenge.

The Collective team are responsible for both the structural and interior build covering 30m². You are welcome to browse our outlined design concept **here**. This requires immediate investment, which is challenging given the very little time to plan and budget. Nevertheless, we are committed and are seeking to raise \$15,000 which will help in removing the immediate CAPEX burden.

PROJECT OUTLINE AND ESTIMATED COST

•	Interior display shelving	USD 3,500.00
•	POS hardware system	USD 1,400.00
•	Interior lighting and power supply	USD 2,000.00
•	Paint (inclusive of decorative mural) & branding	USD 1,300.00
•	Digital Information Screen and sound	USD 1,000.00
