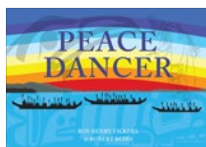

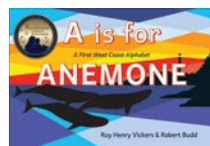

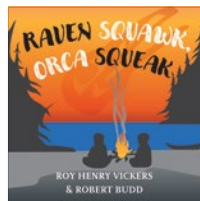

# The Wild Horses of the Chilcotin

*Their History and Future*

.....  
WAYNE MCCRORY

*The Chilcotin's magnificent wild horses are under threat.*

BRITISH COLUMBIA'S VAST CHILCOTIN region is home to a magnificent population of what most people call wild horses, although technically they are "feral" horses since they descend from stock that was long ago tame. They are romantic and beautiful, but they are also controversial: they are seen as intruders competing for range land with native species and domestic cattle and, as a result, they have been subject to government culls and are not officially protected.

In this compelling book, wildlife biologist Wayne McCrory draws upon two decades of research to make a case for considering these wonderful creatures, called *qayus* in traditional T̓silhqot'in culture, a resilient part of the area's balanced prey-predator ecosystem. McCrory also chronicles *qayus*' genetic history and significance to the T̓silhqot'in, juxtaposing their efforts to protect *qayus* against movements to cull them.

**WAYNE MCCRORY** is a registered professional biologist specializing in the study of wild horses, bears and western toads. He has published more than ninety scientific reports on wildlife and conservation, including two technical reports on wild horses in BC and Alberta and, with horse genetics expert Dr. Gus Cothran, two reports on the genetics of wild horses in the Chilcotin. McCrory lives on a small farm in Hills, BC, with his wife, conservationist and journalist Lorna Visser.

# The Curious Passage of Richard Blanshard

*First Governor of Vancouver Island*

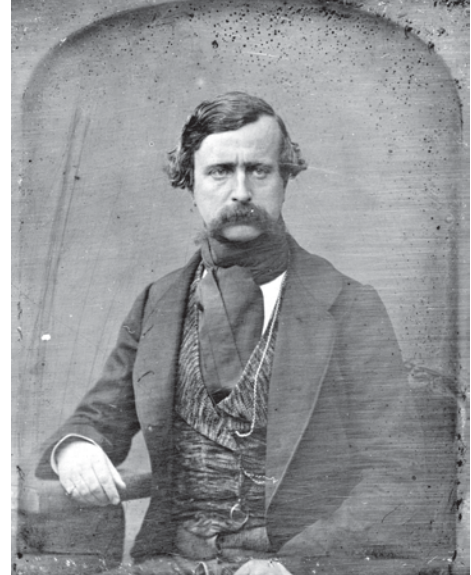

*Celebrated historian Barry Gough brings a defining era of Pacific Northwest history into focus in this biography of Richard Blanshard, the first governor of Vancouver Island—illuminating with intriguing detail the genesis and early days of Canada’s westernmost province.*

EARLY ONE WINTRY DAY in March 1850, after seven weary weeks out of sight of land, a well-dressed Londoner, a bachelor aged thirty-two, stood at the ship’s rail taking in the immensity of the unfolding scene. From Her Britannic Majesty’s paddlewheel sloop-of-war *Driver*, steadily thumping forth on Imperial purpose, all that Richard Blanshard could make out to port, in reflected purple light upon the northern side, was a forested, rock-clad island rising to considerable height. Vancouver’s Island they called it in those far-off days. This was his destination.

Richard Blanshard was governor of the young colony for three short, unhappy years—only one and a half of which were spent in the colony itself. From the very beginning he was at odds with the vastly influential Hudson’s Bay Company, run by its Chief Factor James Douglas, who succeeded Blanshard as governor of the colony of Vancouver Island and later became the first governor of the colony of British Columbia. While James Douglas is remembered, for better or worse, as a founding father of British Columbia, Richard Blanshard’s name is now largely forgotten, despite his vitally important role in warning London of American cross-border aggressions, including a planned takeover of Haida Gwaii. However, his failures highlight the fascinating struggles of the time—the supreme influence of commerce, the disparity between expectations and reality, and the bewildering collision of European and Pacific Northwest culture.

**BARRY GOUGH** is one of Canada’s premier historians and biographers. Among his awards are the Lieutenant Governor’s Medal for Historical Writing, the Canadian Historical Association’s Clio Prize, the Maritime Foundation’s Mountbatten Award, the Washington Historical Society’s Robert Gray Medal, and the Alcala Galiano Medal. Most recently, he was awarded the 2022 Lieutenant Governor’s Medal for Historical Writing for *Possessing Meares Island* (2021). He is a Fellow of the Society for the History of Discoveries. He lives in Victoria, BC, with his wife, Marilyn.

# The Best Loved Boat

*The Princess Maquinna*

.....  
IAN KENNEDY

*Built in 1913, the Canadian Pacific Railway's ship Princess Maquinna steamed up and down the rugged west coast of Vancouver Island in summer and winter, calm weather and storms, for over forty years, and has become one of the most beloved boats in BC's maritime history.*

PRINCESS MAQUINNA, SOMETIMES REFERRED TO as the "Ugly Princess" but most often "Old Faithful," transported Indigenous people, settlers, missionaries, loggers, cannery workers, prospectors and travellers of all kinds up and down Vancouver Island's rugged and dangerous west coast, stopping at up to forty ports of call on her seven-day run. The *Princess Maquinna* faithfully served as the lifeline for all those who lived on the west coast of Vancouver Island before it became accessible by roads. Because of this strong connection she became the "Best Loved Boat" in BC's maritime history. Kennedy recounts battles through eighty-knot gales along the exposed coastline sailors called "The Graveyard of the Pacific," and reveals the bigotry that forced Indigenous and Chinese passengers to remain on the foredeck of the ship while other passengers sheltered from the elements inside. He brings the history of this beloved ship to life with rich detail, recalling a time when this remote part of British Columbia was alive with mines, canneries and now-forgotten settlements.

**IAN KENNEDY** is the author of several books about BC history including *Sunny Sandy Savary* (Kennell Publishing, 1992) and he co-authored *Tofino and Clayoquot Sound* (cloth edition, 2014; paperback edition available in fall 2023). For many years, he has also served as one of Canada's few rugby journalists and has written for numerous magazines around the world. He currently lives in Comox, BC.

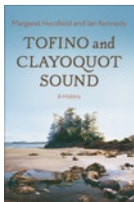

# Douglas Lake

*Empire of Grass*

*Explore the rich history of Canada's largest ranch.*

DOUGLAS LAKE IS THE largest ranch in Canada, encompassing over one million acres of BC's south-central interior, and thousands of people have worked there since it was founded in the mid 1880s. Douglas Lake now includes BC's first cattle ranch, Alkali Lake Ranch, as well as Circle S Ranch, Quilchena Ranch, Riske Creek Ranching and the infamous Gang Ranch. It has had a succession of wealthy owners including Charles "Chunky" Woodward of Woodward's Stores and current owner, US real estate and sports mogul Stan Kroenke. It has recreational facilities and is known for hosting celebrity guests like Prince Philip, billionaire media mogul Malcolm Forbes and others but, as this book shows, it is a serious working cattle ranch.

Having grown up on a BC ranch, author Donna Yoshitake Wuest brings an insider's understanding to the subject. Working closely with the ranch's long-time manager, Joe Gardner, she provides a detailed history from its founding by John Douglas 140 years ago, through innovations in quarter horse breeding and deer farming to helicopter cowboying. Together, Wuest and Gardner provide a fascinating account of the day-to-day operations of a large modern ranch as it faces the challenges of running an integrated cattle, forestry and recreational business. The book is rich with stories about the ranch's wealthy owners, celebrity guests and hard-working cowhands.

**DONNA YOSHITAKE WUEST** has worked as a writer for more than forty years. She was born in Vernon, BC, where she grew up on the Coldstream Ranch during the years when much of the land was orchard. Decades after moving away from the ranch, she wrote *Coldstream: The Ranch Where It All Began* (2005). She works as a freelance journalist and writer in Vancouver, BC.

**JOE W. GARDNER**'s life-long passion has been ranching. He first worked at Douglas Lake Ranch in the early sixties, as a summer job, and he managed the ranch from 1979 to 2019. He has a master's degree in agriculture and currently resides in Vernon, BC.

*Explore the natural glory of hot springs with the updated 4th edition of Hot Springs of Western Canada.*

HOT SPRINGS ARE AMONG western Canada's most enjoyable attractions. Some are famous, like Fairmont and Harrison, and have posh resorts built around them. Some, like Hot Springs Cove in Clayoquot Sound, cascade through a series of natural pools. Many more are hidden away in the wilderness, known only to locals—or owners of this guidebook.

A perennial bestseller now in its fourth updated edition, *Hot Springs of Western Canada* is a comprehensive guide to roughly 115 hot springs located mostly in BC, but also in Alberta, Yukon, the western Northwest Territories and even near the border in Washington and Alaska. It covers access, conditions, history and noteworthy details of these enticing natural wonders. Additionally, there are numerous colour photographs and engaging preface articles explaining the science and history of hot springs. This guide is a must-have for anyone who enjoys a soothing soak, either in a popular park or in the privacy of the wilderness.

**GLENN WOODSWORTH** is a professional field geologist and has been mountaineering, rock climbing and exploring the backcountry of western BC for over sixty years, with an avocational and recreational interest in hot springs for over forty-five years. He has written, edited and contributed to several outdoor guides, including Dick Culbert's classic *A Climber's Guide to the Coastal Ranges of British Columbia* (Alpine Club of Canada, 1965) and Bruce Fairley's *Climbing and Hiking in Southwestern British Columbia* (Gordon Soules Book Publishers, 1986). He has operated Tricouni Press with his wife, Joy Woodsworth, since 1993. He lives in Vancouver, BC.

**DAVID WOODSWORTH's** interest in the outdoors came from his father, whose job as a geologist took him all over the Coast Mountains for three or four months each summer. From as young as seven, David accompanied him on helicopter trips. David has more than fifty years of experience exploring all corners of British Columbia, including several summers exploring the coast by small boat. He also has extensive hiking, backpacking and mountaineering experience, and has trained as a private and commercial pilot. He lives in Delta, BC.

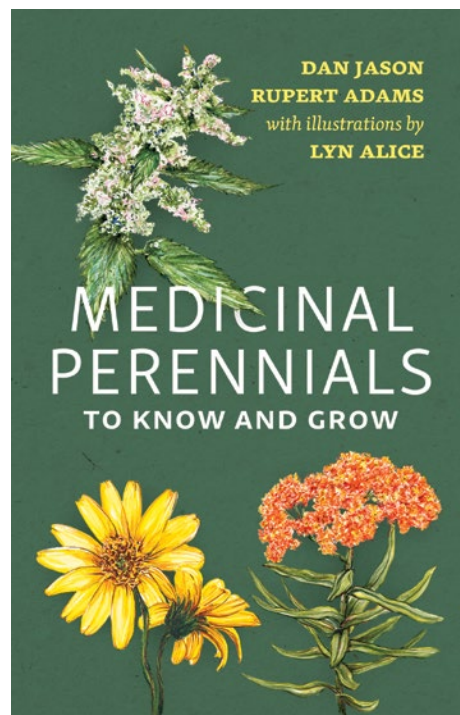
This compact book describes some of the best-known medicinal plants and provides expert information on their care and use. Accompanied by the beautiful watercolour illustrations of Lyn Alice, Dan Jason and Rupert Adams explain the nature of each plant, how to grow them, their medicinal properties and other potential perks, such as their ability to produce dyes or attract pollinators.

Dan Jason has owned and operated the mail-order seed company Salt Spring Seeds since 1986 and Rupert Adams has worked for over two decades with Dan Jason, currently growing a wide variety of vegetable, grain and herb seeds for Salt Spring Seeds and the BC Eco Seed Co-op. The medicinal perennials in this book will be beautiful, useful and environmentally positive additions to any local garden.

**DAN JASON** lives on Salt Spring Island, BC, where he founded the mail-order seed company Salt Spring Seeds. He has written many bestselling books about growing and preparing food sustainably, including *The Whole Organic Food Book* (Raincoast Books, 2001) and *Saving Seeds as if Our Lives Depended on It* (Salt Spring Seeds, 2006).

**RUPERT ADAMS** specializes in growing medicinal herbs and runs his own medicinal herb and tincture business, Kairos Botanicals. Adams worked for three years as a coordinator and advisor to the Bauta Family Initiative on Canadian Seed Security. He currently resides and grows at Abundance Community Farm in Agassiz, BC.

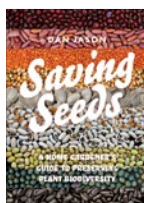

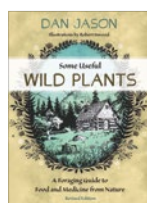

# The Days of Augusta

MARY AUGUSTA TAPPAGE EVANS, EDITED BY JEAN E. SPEARE, PHOTOGRAPHY BY ROBERT KEZIERE

*Hailed as a contemporary classic of oral literature, The Days of Augusta is Shuswap elder Augusta Evans' memories of a lifetime that spanned from 1888 to 1978.*

ACCOMPANIED BY ROBERT KEZIERE'S intimate photographs, Augusta's rhythmic prose reads like poetry. She depicts with strength and eloquence her own story—her days at the Mission School, making baskets and catching salmon, the pain of giving birth and the death of a son—as well as the legends and stories of events told to her—a stagecoach robbery, a woman who was the prisoner of a bear. First printed in 1973, Augusta's story continues to be a fascinating glimpse into the past, with throughlines to the present.

**MARY AUGUSTA TAPPAGE EVANS**, born in 1888 in BC's central interior Cariboo country, was the granddaughter of a Shuswap chief. When she was in her eighties she shared her stories with Jean E. Speare, who formed them into this book, first published in 1973. Augusta passed away in 1978 and is survived by her grandchildren.

**JEAN E. SPEARE** (1921–2022) was born into a pioneer BC family and was raised on a Cariboo ranch. She spent a large part of her life in Barkerville, and her writing about the Cariboo has appeared in many newspapers in the province. At the time *The Days of Augusta* was written, Jean and her husband lived in Williams Lake.

**ROBERT KEZIERE** is a Vancouver photographer. He took the magnificent photographs in this book over the better part of two weeks, photographing Augusta in the cabin that each year became her summer home. Robert Keziere's photographs have been exhibited in Canada, the United States and Europe and are in several public and private collections, including the Canada Council Art Bank and the Canadian Museum of Contemporary Photography.

# Commune

A Novel

AGAINST ALL ODDS, THE dream endures for half a century through fierce internecine squabbling, occasional community uproar, births and deaths, disasters in animal husbandry, the War in the Woods, RCMP raids and the blandishments of oily developers. But throughout it all what abides is the land itself, its gifts and spirits and seasonal graces. A story within a story, the tale is told by the commune's sole remaining occupant to an enigmatic stranger. Herself a recent urban exile exploring the ways of rural living, she succeeds in coaxing him through his rememberings away from grief into renewed life.

Des Kennedy brings his signature humour and intimate knowledge of gardens and woodlands to this engaging novel. Throughout *Commune*, Kennedy poses the big questions—how do we best live our lives? Build community? Create a new paradigm for raising kids, growing food and honouring the genius of our place?

**DES KENNEDY** is an award-winning journalist, broadcaster, author and environmental activist. He is the author of four books of essays including a memoir, *The Passionate Gardener* (Greystone Books, 2006), and three novels including *Climbing Patrick's Mountain* (Brindle & Glass, 2009). Noted as one of the most influential personalities on the Canadian gardening scene, Kennedy writes a regular column for *bcLiving* magazine and has been a columnist for the *Globe and Mail*. He lives on Denman Island, BC.

# The White Light of Tomorrow

.....  
RUSSELL THORNTON

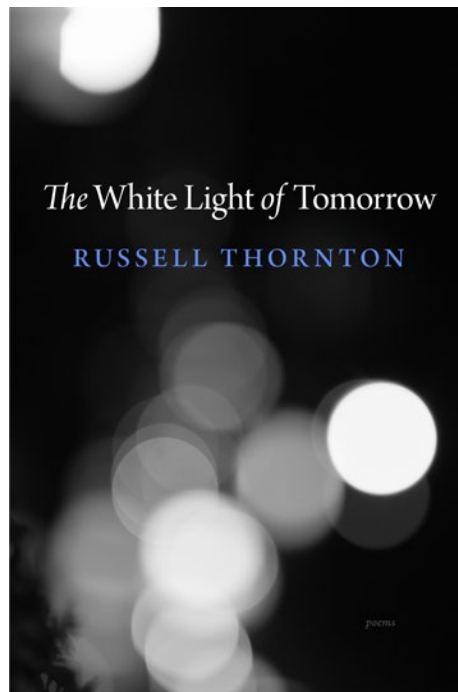
*A masterful new collection from award-winning poet Russell Thornton.*

WITH INTENSE LYRICISM, THORNTON records his imaginative movement between the element of water, waking to “the aloneness of water,” and the phenomenon of light, comprehending “light” as “fate” and “love” as “memory of light.” In the process, Thornton highlights how hard lives can manifest beauty, affirmation. A mother transcends degrading circumstances through laughter. A long-lost father’s drafting set case is a “coffin,” its tools a “skeleton;” his “ashes are buried” in the poet’s “arm.”

Revelations of nature abound. Thornton’s rainy locale lifts onto the mythical level, water “wrapping around” him, “holding” him “complete / as within womb water about to break.” Herons’ wings “span the countless characters” of a creek; a butterfly folds and unfolds “light / like white origami.” A description of an ancient BC site is a rapt engagement with Indigenous petroglyphs. An exploration of a Song of Songs passage details “light ... one with turns of the yarn” of a shawl, “a touch within a touch.” Classical myth informs a poem about a power outage; the speaker enters “the elsewhere of the night” to build a fire.

Passionate, moving, this collection marks a fine advance in Thornton’s expanding poetic output.

**RUSSELL THORNTON**’s collection *The Hundred Lives* (Quattro Books, 2014) was shortlisted for the Griffin Poetry Prize. His *Birds, Metals, Stones & Rain* (2013) was shortlisted for the Governor General’s Literary Award for Poetry, the Raymond Souster Award and the Dorothy Livesay Poetry Prize. His other titles include *The Fifth Window* (2000), *A Tunisian Notebook* (Seraphim Editions, 2002), *House Built of Rain* (2003; shortlisted for the Dorothy Livesay Poetry Prize and the ReLit Award for poetry), *The Human Shore* (2006) and *The Broken Face* (2018). His most recent collection is *Answer to Blue* (2021). Thornton’s poetry has appeared in several anthologies and as part of BC’s Poetry in Transit. He lives in North Vancouver, BC.

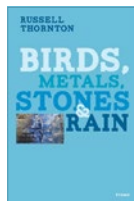

# Tofino and Clayoquot Sound

*A History*

MARGARET HORSFIELD AND IAN KENNEDY

CLAYOQUOT SOUND ON THE west coast of Vancouver Island is not only a place of extraordinary raw beauty, but also a region with a rich heritage and fascinating past.

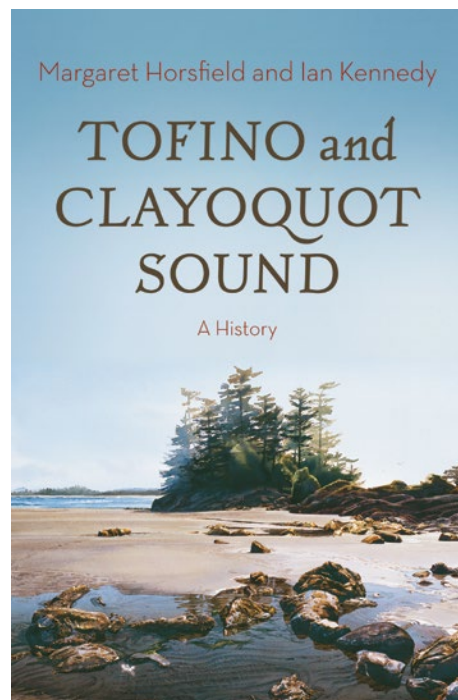
*Tofino and Clayoquot Sound* delves into all facets of the region's history, bringing to life the chronicle that started with the dramatic upheavals of geological formation and continues to the present day. The book tours through the history of the Hesquiaht, Ahousaht and Tla-o-qui-aht as well as other nations that inhabited the area in earlier times. It documents the arrival of Spanish, British and American traders on the coast and their avid greed for sea otter pelts. It follows the development of the huge fur seal industry and its profound impact on the coast. It tracks the establishment of reserve lands and two residential schools. The coming of World War II is discussed, as is the installation of a large Air Force base near Tofino, which changed the town and area dramatically. From here the story spirals into the post-road period. With gravel and asphalt came tourism, newcomers, the counter-culture of the 1960s, the establishment of Pacific Rim National Park and, of course, surfing. The book also addresses logging—which became the main industry in the area—and its questionable practices, going into detail about the War in the Woods: the world-famous conflict and largest mass arrest in Canadian history.

A place is shaped by its people, and Horsfield and Kennedy highlight notable figures of past and present: the merchants, missionaries, sealers and settlers; the eternally optimistic prospectors; the Japanese fishermen and their families; the hippies; the storm- and whale-watchers; the Indigenous elders and leaders.

Offering an overall survey of the history of the area, *Tofino and Clayoquot Sound* is extensively researched and illustrated with historic photos and maps; it evokes the spirit and culture of the area and illuminates how the past has shaped the present.

**MARGARET HORSFIELD** is the author of several books including *Voices from the Sound* (Salal Books, 2008) and *Cougar Annie's Garden* (Salal Books, 1999), which won the Roderick Haig-Brown Regional Prize. She has also worked in radio and print journalism. She lives in Nanaimo, BC.

**IAN KENNEDY** is the author of several books about BC history including *Sunny Sandy Savary* (Kennell Publishing, 1992) plus his newest book, *The Best Loved Boat* (available in fall 2023). For many years, he has also served as one of Canada's few rugby journalists and has written for numerous magazines around the world. He currently lives in Comox, BC.

# Decrim

*How We Decriminalized Drugs in British Columbia*

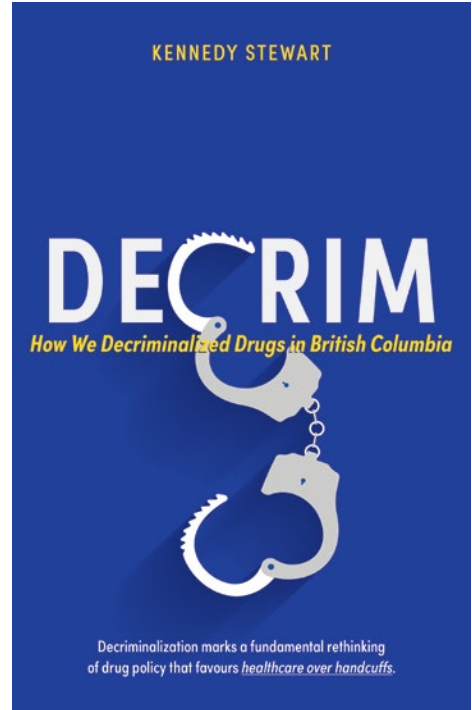

*A timely, insider account of an important and controversial step in British Columbia's strategic effort to respond to the overdose crisis.*

CANADA IS IN THE middle of an opioid crisis. Since the province of British Columbia declared a public health emergency in 2016, more than 9,400 people have died of drug poisoning in BC—an average of six people a day—with nearly 1,500 apparent opioid-related deaths in the first eight months of 2022.

In *Decrim*, Kennedy Stewart, mayor of Vancouver from 2018 to 2022, recounts historic progress in addressing this crisis. January 31, 2023, is the beginning of a three-year trial period for decriminalizing the possession of small amounts of hard drugs in British Columbia, a ground-breaking change in Canada's approach to drug use. Kennedy Stewart has written *Decrim* to tell the story of how this remarkable policy change came about and the enormous challenges faced by those who fought for it—including its contribution to him losing his bid for mayoral re-election. In *Decrim*, Stewart lays out how ending the “war on drugs” and recognizing the overdose crisis as a public health issue will help reduce stigma related to substance use, increase access to health services, and decrease harms related to criminalization in British Columbia.

**KENNEDY STEWART** is a politician, educator, author, and co-editor of *Turning Parliament Inside Out: Practical Ideas for Reforming Canada's Democracy* (Douglas & McIntyre, 2017). After serving as mayor of Vancouver for four years he is now returning to teaching at Simon Fraser University. He lives in Vancouver, BC.

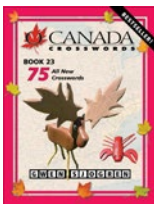

We're here to bring light to an otherwise grave subject, friends. It's only natural to laugh while crying. I bring story to life. One minute I'm a songbird singing from a bough, the next, I'm rapture. I connect you to the realm of spirit... Well, as best I can, given your mundane allocation.

Follow us through primordial visions, dance with a cannibal (don't worry, they're friendly once tamed) and discover what it takes to be united. Together, we'll have fun. Together, we are one. So tuck in, and believe what you'll believe, for who knows what yesterday brings. Amen and all my relations, all my relations and amen.

**BRANDON REID** holds a B.Ed. from UBC, with a specialization in Indigenous education, and a journalism diploma from Langara College. His work has been published in the *Barely South Review*, the *Richmond Review* and *The Province*. He is a member of the Heiltsuk First Nation, with a mix of Indigenous and English ancestry. # Grandview Drive

*A debut short story collection investigating the strange and unexpected intersections of loneliness and connection.*

FROM HIS CAR, A lonely, heartbroken man secretly watches strangers going about their lives in the comfort of their own homes; when caught, he wrecks his car in an attempt to escape. A man hears a car wreck outside his home and has a wild night of romance with a strange woman he meets at the scene. A reclusive old writer starts to believe he is becoming his own characters as he writes. A college student looks to his girlfriend's diary for pointers on how he should act. A mother confronted with her estranged son's death by car wreck organizes a memorial service for a list of attendees she has never met.

This collection of sixteen connected short stories investigates the ways we humans so often feel lonely and alone, yet cannot avoid having our lives be contingent upon others—often in ways we can neither see nor understand. Blackett's characters long for meaningful connection and struggle to find it; they are too often unaware of the connections that are right in front of them.

*Grandview Drive* is a collection that builds on itself; the stories stand on their own, but they are strengthened by the (sometimes secret) connections they hold with each other. Blackett's debut asks the reader to think about love and loss, loneliness and heartbreak, redemption and starting life anew.

**TIM BLACKETT** is a Canadian writer whose work has appeared in *Briarpatch*, *[spaces]* and a small Saskatchewan journal called *Swift, Flowing*. He holds a Bachelor of Theology and a BA in English from the University of Regina, as well as a certificate in creative writing from Humber College. His forthcoming short story collection, *Grandview Drive*, placed second in the John V. Hicks Long Manuscript Award (2019), and the titular story was longlisted for the Carter v. Cooper Short Fiction Award (2012). Blackett lives in Regina, SK.

Housty's poems are textural—blossoms, feathers, stubborn blots of snow—and reading them is a sensory offering that invites the reader's whole body to be transported in the experience. Their writing converses with mountains, animals and all our kin beyond the human realm as they sit beside their ancestors' bones and move throughout the geography of their homeland. Housty's exploration of history and futurity, ceremony and sexuality, grieving and thriving invites us to look both inward and outward to redefine our sense of community.

Through these poems we can explore living and loving as a practice, and placemaking as an essential part of exploring our humanity and relationality.

**JESS HOUSTY** (Cúagilákv) is a parent, writer and grassroots activist with Heiltsuk (Indigenous) and mixed settler ancestry. They serve their community as an herbalist and land-based educator alongside broader work in the non-profit and philanthropic sectors. They are inspired and guided by relationships with their homelands, their extended family and their non-human kin, and they are committed to raising their children in a similar framework of kinship and land love. They reside and thrive in their unceded ancestral territory in the community of Bella Bella, BC.

A LONG POEM IN six sections, *Dream House* takes its cue from Gaston Bachelard's *Poetics of Space* in its investigation of female embodiment by calling up such feral, liminal spaces as the pregnant body, the aging mind, snail shells, broom closets, low-ceilinged pubs and abandoned pizza boxes. Part Tardis, part townhouse, part Howl's moving castle, this wry, surreal and many-peopled narrative interrogates what metaphor might hold of history, both personal and social, in the wake of a mother's passing. Its migrant speaker trawls through hedgerows and recipe books to unearth stained birdsong and undead civil wars, intent on tracing a matrilineal path across four generations while traversing the haunted margins between existence and belonging.

**CATHY STONEHOUSE** (she/they) is a poet, writer, teacher and visual artist who migrated as a young adult from Thatcher's England to Vancouver, BC—the unceded traditional territories of the Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh nations—where she still lives. The author of a novel, *The Causes* (Pedlar Press, 2019), a collection of short fiction, *Something About the Animal* (Biblioasis, 2011) and two previous collections of poetry—*Grace Shiver* (Inanna Publications, 2011) and *The Words I Know* (Press Gang, 1994), Stonehouse co-edited the groundbreaking anthology *Double Lives: Writing and Motherhood* (McGill-Queen's University Press, 2008), is a previous editor of *EVENT* magazine and currently teaches creative writing and interdisciplinary expressive arts at Kwantlen Polytechnic University.

*A History of Twin Islands*

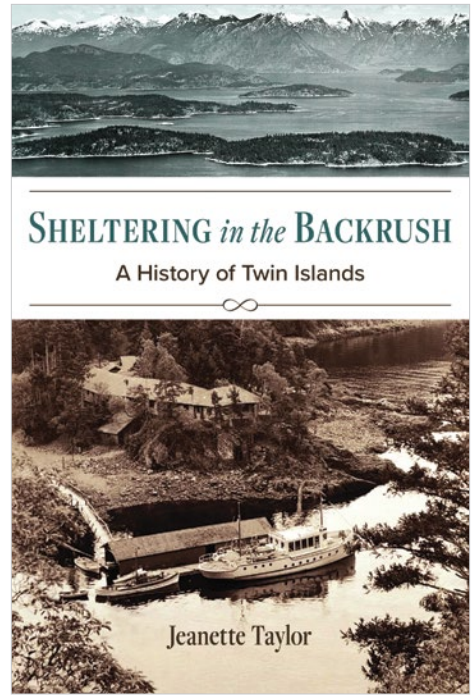

TWIN ISLANDS FORM part of the lacy fringe at the southern edge of the Discovery Islands archipelago, where it meets the north Salish Sea. This is the interface between wilderness and urban settlement. To the north, heavily treed slopes rise vertically from the sea and fast tides churn through the constricted passages of a maze of islands and inlets. Navigating these waters is a white-knuckle challenge many recreational boaters avoid, ending their travels to the east in Desolation Sound Marine Park. To the south, the topography relaxes into a more habitable environment of open waters, villages, towns and highways. Those who do find their way to Twin are richly rewarded by a beautiful and tranquil destination—with a fascinating past.

Discovery of a trove of sepia-toned pictures of Twin Islands from the late 1930s drew Jeanette Taylor to research and document the history of the islands. She found a live-wire cast of characters typical of remote places, including a one-legged sheep farmer; an aristocratic Irish priest who was the victim of an unsolved murder; American tycoons fleeing Japan on the cusp of World War II; German royalty; and an anonymous heiress who rescued the islands from logging.

Through it all, Taylor found a thread among Twin’s people, passed from one generation to the next—like an invisible torch handed over with the deed: a love of nature and the place. Illustrated with historical photos and engagingly written, *Sheltering in the Back Rush* is an important addition to Harbour Publishing’s catalogue of coastal BC history.

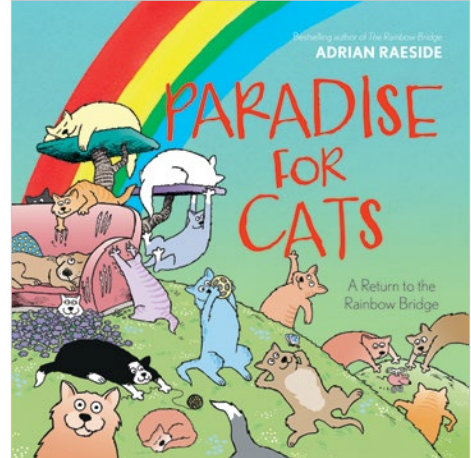

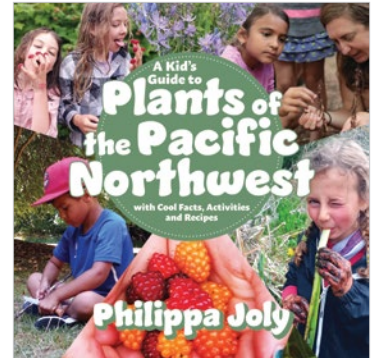

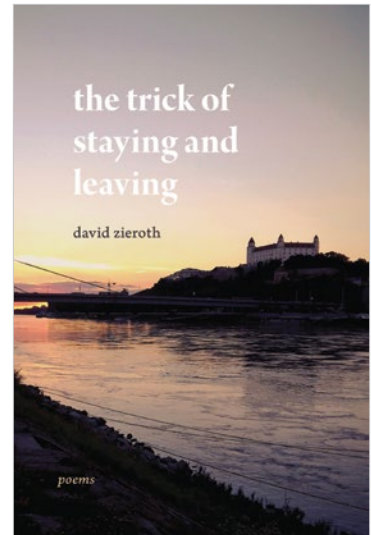


## the trick of staying and leaving

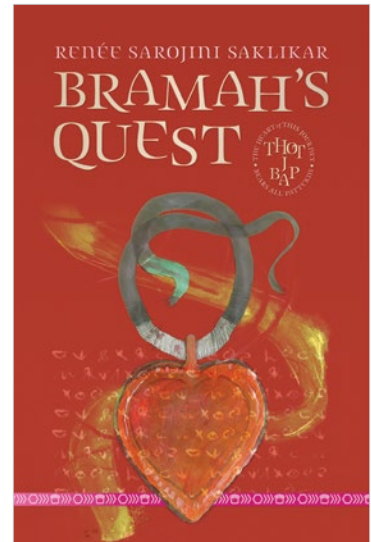
## Bramah's Quest

## Burr

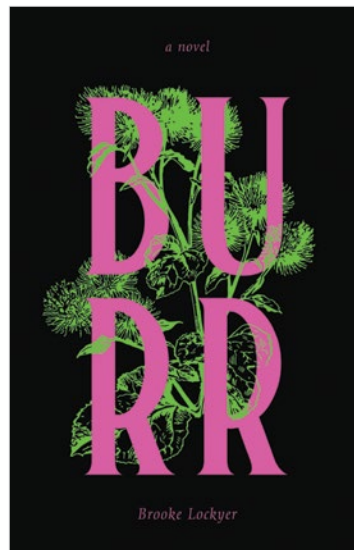
BROOKE LOCKYER

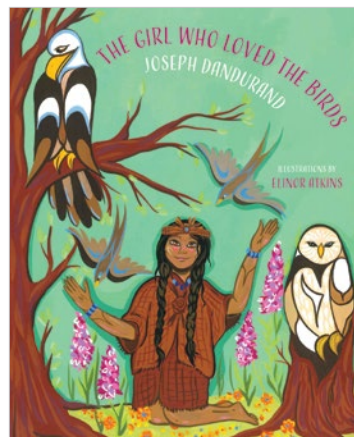

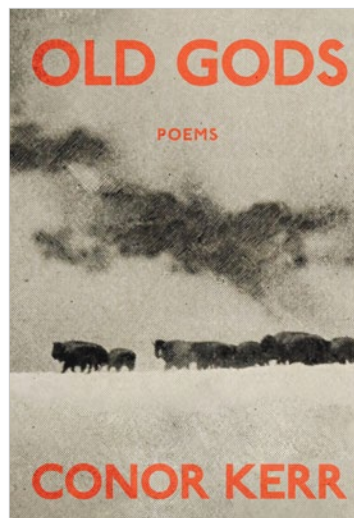
## Old Gods
