





For Jean and Sam, Avenel has always been about community. The two began dating in 2011 and were temporarily renting in Bethesda when they decided to look for a permanent home. When they visited Avenel in 2014, it was their established local relationships and the welcoming environment that drew them there and convinced them to become residents. "We were attracted to Avenel because it's so close to Jean's salon, a mile or so to the Village and Holy Child," says Sam, "and because it's a real community with walking paths, a park with ball fields, and plenty of safe space for dog walking and getting outside to meet people."

Sam's daughter Sophia attended Holy Child, and the proximity between Avenel and her school was a draw for the family. Now 21, Sophia is a senior at the University of Rhode Island. Avenel is also near McLean, Virginia, a plus for both Sam and his 19-year-old son Beau. Beau attended Langley High School in McLean before matriculating to Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, where he is now a sophomore. Sam, meanwhile, has long been familiar with McLean; he is president of Centrum Inc., an IT company headquartered there. Sam himself was born in Potomac and attended Gonzaga High School before earning his degree from the University of Maryland College Park in consumer economics and business.

Avenel has also proved a perfect location because of Jean's business, Salon Jean & Day Spa, located at MacArthur Boulevard and Seven Locks Road in Cabin John. Born in Seoul Korea and raised in College Park, Maryland, from the age of 5, Jean has always loved experimenting with hair and makeup. At 14, she even started selling Avon cosmetics door to door.



But Jean's work isn't just about hair and makeup, it's the daily client interactions and personal relationships that develop over time that attract her to the salon business, and in response, the clients to Jean. After working for a number of years at a Potomac salon, 14 years ago Jean decided to start her own business, a place where she could build her brand and implement her unique personalized customer service.

Since then, Salon Jean has quickly grown into a community establishment, one of the small businesses that are part of the soul of the local community. In fact, the salon is one of the accomplishments that Jean is most proud of in her life, in large part because she has successfully created a safe, nurturing place for individuals to develop their own careers. "For me, it's about the personal satisfaction that comes along with life and career coaching while teaching technical skills," says Jean. "And of course, helping people look and feel great."

In fact, it is because of Salon Jean and a bit of serendipity about a detour from River Road one day that Sam found Jean. The two had known each other for about 20 years before they started dating — they had similar friends in the area but weren't in touch except for occasionally running into each other in Potomac Village

while doing errands. One day almost II years ago, Sam had to detour on his way to work down MacArthur Boulevard. He said he saw the Salon Jean & Day Spa sign and I thought, "I wonder if that's Jean? I haven't seen her for years." Shortly thereafter, he booked an appointment to say hello. They reacquainted themselves, and the two had their first date at a restaurant on Bethesda Row.

We were attracted to Avenel because it's so close to Jean's salon, a mile or so to the Village and Holy Child.

Jean says she's forever grateful to her business advisor for insisting she name the salon for herself. She originally had decided and produced signage with another name, but her adviser recommended that she incorporate her own name as the title because she had developed a professional following in the area. He also teased that she needed to open her

own business and put her name out there to find her husband. "It's amazing – I changed that sign, and that's how I met Sam." In 2016, the couple eloped in Maui.

Sam and Jean are now close friends with a number of Jean's clients and their extended families as a result of the salon. "Our favorite memory from Avenel is the fun we had celebrating the salon's 10-year anniversary by throwing a holiday disco-themed costume party at TPC Potomac for Jean's employees, clients, and friends. It was a perfect party venue, and we all had a terrific evening with one another," said Jean.

As a pet lover, Jean has even managed to incorporate these furry friends into the day-to-day business of her salon. She enjoys using her salon to engage the community in her efforts to raise money for the Montgomery County Humane Society and Pet Connect fostering program. For a number of years, the salon has been inviting clients to enter pictures of their dogs and cats for a pet calendar contest. The community then votes on their favorite photos, and the salon publishes the calendar every November, with 100% of the proceeds going to these animal rescue organizations. As you may be wondering, yes, Jean's salon is absolutely pet-friendly. The calendars are available in mid-November and make perfect holiday gifts.

Sam and Jean have a dog of their own, an 8-year-old Maltipoo named Oscar. Oscar literally goes everywhere with the couple, and Jean gives him everything he could desire. "Sam says, if he returns to this planet again in another life form, he wants to come back as one of my dogs," Jean quips.

The couple loves living nearby the C&O Canal and Great Falls so that they can take Oscar frequently on

long walks. For longer excursions, they have a place on the Chesapeake Bay over on Maryland's Eastern Shore, where they like to spend as much time as possible. They are avid boaters, catching sunsets and an occasional fish. During the fall and spring, they enjoy riding their motorcycle in the country and mountains, often making trips to Shenandoah's Skyline Drive, West Virginia's Harpers Ferry, and Maryland's northern rural belt.

Back in Avenel, Jean and Sam like to stay engaged in the community and support small local businesses as much as possible. In terms of restaurants, they particularly enjoy Raku, Wild Tomato, Fish Taco, and Renato's at the village. Sam, meanwhile, has just started his second term on the Avenel Standards Committee.





They stay largely unplugged from mainstream media, especially news, watching only stand-up comedy, selective documentaries, and sports (these long time Marylanders love the Washington Nationals and the Washington Capitals.) In

keeping with this unplugged relationship to most mainstream media is the couple's love of long walks and hikes, reading, fitness, yoga, and meditation.

Since moving to Avenel in 2014, Jean and Sam have found that it is the perfect neighborhood for their community-oriented lifestyle. One moment, in particular, stands out for the couple, says Jean: "the last blizzard proved to be a moment in time that not only blanketed our community in deep snow but created a peaceful, neighborly atmosphere as we all dug out and helped one another."

MacArthur Plaza Property Manager Brad Klinedinst also detailed the many changes management has made to the shopping center and offices since the pandemic broke out, including following all Center for Disease Control and Prevention safety protocols and recommendations within the Montgomery County Health Department guidelines. Management steps include continued enhanced disinfection and cleaning, making a safe space for expanded outdoor dining, promoting mask wearing, and displaying safe distancing signage. It also has installed a new, state-of-the-art HVAC ventilation system that allows more fresh air to enter the buildings.

For those who may be working from home, but looking for an office outside the home, several private offices are available. MacArthur Plaza also is considering converting one larger suite into a properly distanced co-working area. Office floor plans

Avenel Living: What has been your biggest challenge since COVID-19 broke out early this year.

Jean Bae: Our biggest challenge has been getting clients to come back to the salon and just getting the word out about all the protocols we are doing across the board to keep everyone safe – disinfecting, wearing masks and goggles, putting Plexiglas barriers between stations, temperature checks, hand washing, and setting up a heated tent outside to offer our services there.

Francis Namin: Our biggest challenge was that everything was uncertain. We didn't know how strong business would be upon reopening, or if it would even be sustainable. Luckily, we received a warm welcome back from the community and we were able to gradually bring back all of our team. Another challenge was adjusting from doing 30% carryout to 90% carryout. We've had to staff heavier, as each carryout order takes more time to package, and costs more due to the containers. The cost of carryout containers and the amount we use has skyrocketed, compounded by trying to use eco-friendly products as much as possible. Another difficulty has been the added steps for sanitization, and personal safety due to COVID. All of our costs across the board, food and cleaning containers have gone up significantly.

Stephanie and Damian Salvatore: The safety of our guests and employees has always been our top priority. Figuring out the best way to keep everyone healthy and continue doing business in a climate where the guidelines keep changing has been truly challenging. Closing in April was a terrifying decision but ultimately it gave us the time to navigate the crisis and ultimately open under protective and compliant protocols. This has been a team effort and we are grateful for all the advice and assistance from the other business owners in the mall as well as customers, friends, and our landlords.

Avenel Living: Looking back on last spring and summer, what are you most proud of during this time.

Jean Bae: I am definitely proud that I have a great team who is keeping safe by following strict protocols, and proud that clients can come in knowing that we are doing the right things to keep everyone safe.

Francis Namin: I am most proud of my team for pulling together and supporting me in facing this year's difficulties. The situation this spring and summer was obviously difficult for all of us, but we've learned and adjusted. I'm very proud of my managers and kitchen staff for all their hard work, and putting themselves at risk. Still, through all these difficulties, we've kept preparing fresh, high-quality food. I'd like to thank our customers for their understanding while enduring these difficult conditions.

Stephanie and Damian Salvatore: Damian is a local guy and my family has lived in Cabin John for over 30 years. This area is home to us and we are proud we were able to contribute to the community and create a gathering place where family, friends, and neighbors can come together.

Avenel Living: What positives, professionally and personally, have come out of this time for you?

Jean Bae: I think for me it's been coaching my staff to create a positive mindset and keeping our spirits high, and team building. I am proud that we are open right now. Keeping myself on a budget, working with a skeleton staff, but all working to help each other. We are all in this together and are making great efforts to be a good solid team while being careful to ensure we stay safe both in and outside the salon.

Francis Namin: I've become more flexible. I'm also thankful to be in such a great community, which is so supportive.

Stephanie and Damian Salvatore: Both professionally and personally, we continue to evolve with the changing climate and continue to push forward, operating the restaurants within county health guidelines. Small businesses like ours are struggling, and we continue to persevere in a trying situation. We are staying the course and focused on doing what we do best-Gather and Eat!

The Greg Gannon CANNED FOOD DRIVE

At a very young age, my parents started encouraging me to help others who were less fortunate. I learned from their wonderful example of getting involved by volunteering at soup kitchens for the homeless and delivering gifts to families at their homes who couldn't afford to buy them during the holidays.

When we were raising our two kids, my husband Jonathan and I looked for ways to involve them in programs to support others. The Greg Gannon Canned Food Drive had been around for years at our neighborhood parish in Washington, DC. We signed up to collect food for the drive that took place every December. We teamed up with another family who lived across the street from us and canvassed our streets dropping off an empty grocery bag to about 100 houses asking for donations. A few

days later, we went back out to collect the filled bags with non-perishable food items. We were one of about 80 who collected over 50,000 cans each year and donated them to food banks and shelters here in the Washington area.

This outreach program provides families the opportunity to work together in their own community collecting nonperishable food, which is then donated to local food pantries, like the Southern Maryland Food Bank, Mana Food Center, and The Capital Area Food Bank.

After a few years, I joined the leadership team helping to organize the drive and eventually, to recruit other parish neighborhoods to do their own food drives. Now, there are 14 separate food drives each December! Volunteering this way, and knowing my kids are involved, is very rewarding.

Over the last six months, during this very difficult pandemic, there has been an even greater need for food. Our Greg Gannon





Canned Food Drive team got together and wanted to figure out how we could help but also be safe and use COVID precautions. We held an online monetary donation collection through our website and raised over \$65,000! With those donations, we teamed up with the SHARE Food Network and each week purchase from them fresh and frozen food packs that support over 15 different organizations that serve the struggling families in our communities.

Every Wednesday since mid-April my teenagers Madison and Matthew help me pick up fresh and frozen food packs from the SHARE Food Network warehouse in Landover. We deliver them to different food distribution centers for the homeless and less fortunate. It only takes a few hours each week but the sense of providing help and some relief goes a long way.

We will still hold our 33rd Annual Greg Gannon Food Drives the first weekend in December. They will run a little differently but the energy and the mission will be the same: families helping families! There are many ways to become involved. Start a new drive, volunteer with an existing drive, donate food or money at any time. Our website is **www.ggcfd.org.**
