Let's Go!

You will need to access the internet to complete this Trail, and in particular use the Streetview function in Google Maps. It is important that you enter the precise URL shown in the directions to ensure that you are standing in the correct virtual location to search.

Adventure Details

Your task is to visit 5 great British sporting venues. In each place you need to find a number. You then need to add up these 5 numbers to reach the correct total.

Directions

First off, we are going to Northamptonshire and the place where the first ever race in the newly created World Championship of Drivers took place in 1950. It's Silverstone, the current home of the British Grand Prix in Formula One. <https://goo.gl/maps/scPM793Rb6LrxoMb8>

Clue 01

Welcome to the Silverstone Pitwall. Not many get the chance to stand here on race day! An easy clue to start your adventure; what total do you get if you take the red car from the blue car?

Directions

Right, we are off to the second-largest stadium in the world with a fully retractable roof, which was the second stadium in Europe to have this feature. It's the Principality Stadium in Cardiff. <https://goo.gl/maps/nnAomQ7T85DtWCnf7>

Clue 02

Welcome to pitchside of the national stadium of Wales. What you need to do here is find the name 'Gareth'.

What number is to the right of this name, after the letter 'L'?

Directions

Now we are going to the home of the world's oldest sporting museum. Named after its founder, Thomas Lord, it is the home of Middlesex County Cricket Club and is widely referred to as the 'Home of Cricket'. It is Lord's. <https://goo.gl/maps/PZ9dT6METkHKqX3A8>

Clue 03

Welcome to Jonathan Agnew's view of Lords as he commentates on a match. However, your job is to complete this sequence of numbers: 37, 40, 49, --?

Directions

After the home of cricket, it is only right that we visit the oldest and most prestigious golf club in the world, based in St Andrews, Fife, Scotland, and regarded as the worldwide "Home of Golf".

Clue 04

Welcome to the 1st tee of The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews. The famous 18th green is just to your left. What total would you get if you changed the time that this party is setting off to the 24 hour clock and then added together the hours and minutes of that time?

Directions

To finish, we are off to the venue with 90,000 seats, which makes it the largest football stadium in England, the largest stadium in the UK and the second largest stadium in Europe.
