They'll only spill the beans if we can prove our clue-solving skills. Can you work out which one of them knows the full story behind why the mystery location was dropped and what the mystery item has to do with it? Good luck Staycationers!

Stop 01

Our tour kicks off at the 8th best university in the world: UCL. Locate the main auad, face the pillars and zoom in on the inscription. Eliminate the professor lurking at the start of the second line.

Stop 02

Sherborne School is one of the oldest schools in the UK! Admire the front of the neighbouring abbey from Half Moon St. A professor is lurking nearby above an arrow at this end of Diaby Rd.

Stop 03

Next stop Oxford! Christopher Wren built the Sheldonian theatre for the university in the 1660s. Locate it and study the flat side of it. A professor is lurking above the pillar to the right of the door.

Stop 04

Stowe School has its own aolf course and first class cricket around! Locate the man on a horse by the cricket ground and you'll find another professor lurking on the plinth.

What to do: Solve the clues to eliminate 12 of the professors below. Each clue will require you to explore virtually using Google Streetview in order to spot the answers you need. Every answer will help identify one of our professors. Cross them off as you go and you'll be left with one at the end.
