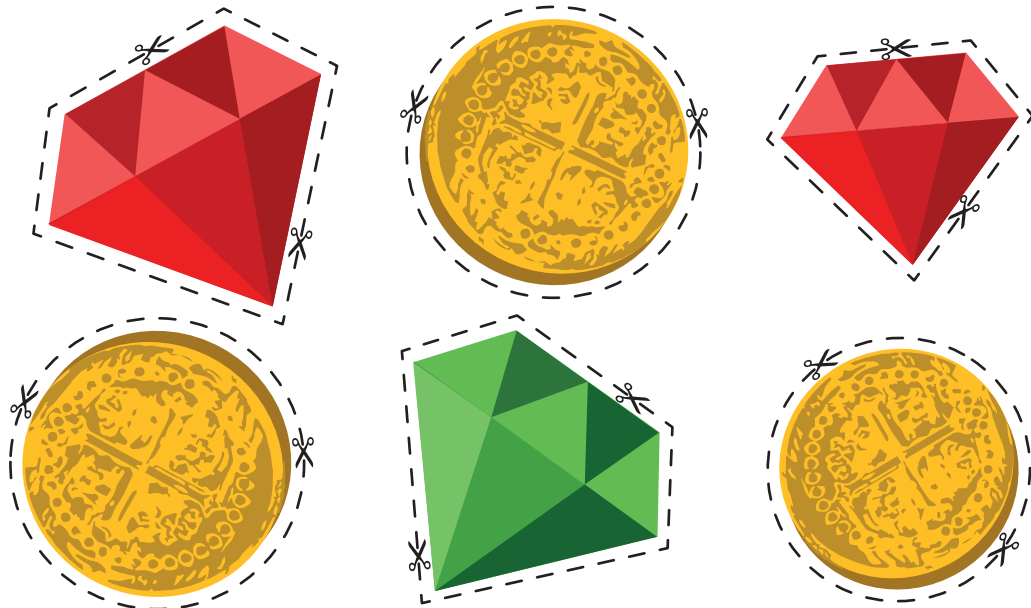
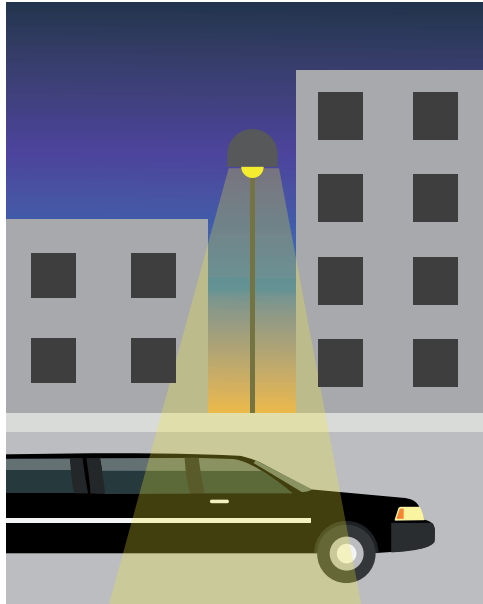


WORLD POETRY DAY

Instructions for adults:

Adult adventurers, below are a series of clues, each with a missing word at the end. We’re sure you can work them out, but we’ve provided the answers as well.

You will need to print these clues out and cut along all of the dotted lines. Your task is to hide them around your home, in the relevant places, and have your child/children find them. There are further instructions below to help you where to hide them.

Don’t have any children? Maybe you know another adult adventurer who would enjoy this.

You can hide anything you’d like in the final hiding spot. We’ve provided some treasure pieces you can cut out and hide, or maybe you’d like to save this treasure hunt for Easter and hide some Easter eggs at the end.

Clue Instruction

- Clue 1:** Give to the treasure hunter/s
- Clue 2:** Hide in shoes
- Clue 3:** Hide under hairbrush
- Clue 4:** Hide by the TV
- Clue 5:** Hide by a teddy bear
- Clue 6:** Hide at a table etc. where they eat meals
- Clue 7:** Hide in a letterbox

Finally: Hide the treasure pieces or your own treasure on their bed, along with the “Well Done” sign.
