


The one who has recorded the second-fastest serve for a woman in an official WTA match is innocent and can be released.






Can you solve the mysterious case of "The Umpire's Last Call"?

Factfile...


There have been only five years since the Championships moved to this location that there has been no rain during the event - 1931, 1976, 1977, 1993 and 1995.
