
Woolpack Battery - Answers



1. Easy Peasy...

Our easy level question is:

How many years is it from the war with France to the most recent time that the later generation of big guns were installed on The Garrison?

2. Mind Twister...

Our medium level question is:

Note down the words that that have 2 of the same double letters next to each other. Which of these words is repeated most often?

3. Brain Buster...

Our hard level question is:

Using only the illustration, multiply "P" by "C". Now divide this by "B". What is the total?

Answers:

Easy:

The war with France is noted as 1796 and the most recent year mentioning the later generation of big guns being installed on The Garrison is 1901. This means that the answer is 105 years.

Medium:

The words that that have 2 of the same double letters next to each other are as follows (with the number of times each appears):

Woolpack (4) Battery (7)Garrison (3)Batteries (1)Impressive (1) Attempting (1)Programme (1) Skilfully (1)Walls (1) Needed (1)Installed (1)Allowed (1) Pillbox (1)Essential (1) Kenning (1)

So the word that appears most frequently is "Battery".

Hard:

In the illustration, "P" = "People", "C" = "Cannons" and "B" = "Buildings".

There are 8 people, 12 cannons and 2 buildings, so 8x12=96 – and then divide this by 2 to reach the final answer of **48**.
