STOURHEAD

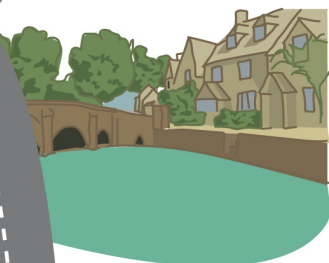
An 18th century landscape garden with lakeside walks, grottoes and classical temples, perfect for a bit of nature spotting.

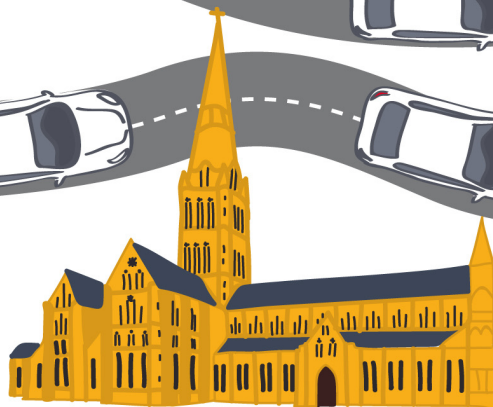
