

INSTRUCTIONS FOR A (RELATIVELY) RESPONSIBLE ADULT

WHAT'S THIS?

The Mini Explorer Club Passport is for young explorers. Inside are top tips on how to be an ace adventurer, and secret challenges for them to complete whilst travelling to and from the Trail. The Passport booklet can be used for up to three treasure hunt themed Trails, with space to record completed expeditions and challenges.

WHAT TO DO

Here's a handy little guide to get ready for your expedition:

- 1. Print out the Mini Explorer Club Passport booklet on A4 paper (pages 3&4 of this PDF file). You can either print it double sided or print out two sheets and stick them together. You'll need one booklet for each mini adventurer you're taking with you on the Trail.
- 2. Fold the Passport in half twice to create an A6 booklet, with the "Secret Challenges" hidden on the inside and this page shown opposite as the front cover. Pass this to the young explorer before your Trail adventure so that they can prepare for their quest.
- Print out the page with the two ID cards on it (page 2 of this PDF file). Cut out the ID cards and keep hold of them for now.





4. Lastly, the sheet with the ID cards also includes the questions and answers to the secret challenges in the Passport. This is known as the "Key" and is for you to keep hold of.



5. Go out on your Trail adventure and become real-life intrepid explorers! Don't forget to take the Passport, ID cards and instructions with you.

WHAT ABOUT AFTER OUR ADVENTURE?

- After working out the location of the loot on your Trail, present the ID card to the young explorer as a great keepsake. There's space for them to add their explorer name and a photograph. When you get home, you can stick the ID card into the special space in their Mini Explorer Club Passport.
- After your Trail adventure, be sure to submit your final answer on our website (www.treasuretrails.co.uk/submit-answer). If you've located the treasure, you'll be entered into our monthly prize draw to win £100!
- 3. After submitting the answer, you'll also get another batch of goodies (even if you didn't get the right location). You'll get some more ID cards, in case you lose these ones, and the three levels of Super Seeker Skills badges that can be cut out and stuck to the back page of the Passport booklet. The idea is that the child gets one per Trail adventure, but it's up to you how you want to give these out!
- 4. There will also be a letter from the Mini Detective Club, and the Mini Secret Agent Club, requesting the young explorer's help to solve another mystery.

WHAT NOW?

Go and have fun on your Trail hunt adventure!

ID CARD & SECRET CHALLENGE INSTRUCTIONS

MINI EXPLORER CLUB ID CARDS

Essential for any ace adventurer: their ID card. Make sure that you have cut this out before you go on your Trail adventure.

We recommend keeping the ID card secret and giving it to the young explorer after solving the last Clue - this will really add to the achievement! You could stick it onto some cardboard or laminate it, after adding a picture of the child and their Explorer Name, to make it even better.

We've supplied two in case more than one child is taking part in the Trail. More than two? Just print more pages.





SECRET CHALLENGES - INSTRUCTIONS & KEYS

Hidden inside the Mini Explorer Club Passport booklet are three secret challenges for the young explorer to solve. This will get them into the theme of the Trail and could be used to keep them entertained on the journey to or from the Trail.

Without the instructions below, the child won't know what to do - making you the keeper of the Key! If you want to give all three challenges to the child then you can, but we'd recommend one per Trail. Make sure they record the challenge completion in their Adventure Log too.

The challenges are graded from easy to hard, and the young explorer can work their way up the difficulty levels. The easy one can be done by any age, whilst the harder ones require reading skills, so may need some adult assistance for younger explorers.

Challenge 1 - Easy: The Treasure Map

Instructions: It's time to brush up on some observation skills! Place a cross over each item when it is spotted whilst you are exploring. The last one left is where the treasure is hidden! When the young explorer spots this on the Trail, they will win the challenge.



Challenge 2 - Medium: Digging for Treasure!

Instructions: There are a number of tunnels which could be dug to find the treasure, but the young explorer should follow tunnel 2! As they dig down, they need to collect the letters to spell out the treasure to discover and collect in order to complete the challenge.

Answer: 10p coin dated 2018




Challenge 3 - Hard: The Treasure Chest

Instructions: Focus only on the diamonds. Reading from left to right, top to bottom, real-life treasure will be revealed! To pass this challenge, the young explorer will need to discover and collect this treasure whilst on the Trail!

You can repeat this Challenge with different gems on future journeys.


SECRET CHALLENGES


