



Upstairs oasis

Much of their house boasts large windows and open spaces, so the Chans wanted a private, cozy master suite. With ash-paneled walls and low-glare fixtures, the bedroom serves as a sumptuous retreat. Relatively compact, it lives large by connecting to an expansive bath and dressing room and a terrace with prime ocean views.

The master bath enjoys amenities of its own, including handsome wood veneer cabinetry, a luxurious soaking tub, and a vivid interplay of light and dark tones. Jet black wenge walls contrast with luminous stonework and glass-bowl sinks, giving the space a modern, sophisticated feel.
