

CRYSTAL BICONE PATTERN COLLECTION

Learn the basic stitches of beadweaving while creating these 5 amazing projects.



FEATURING:

Blazing Bicones, Anytime Necklace, Cupid's Heart, Crystal 2 Layer Flower Bracelet, Nightfall earrings



5: Once you reach the end, go through the 11/0, the (2) Bicones B, the (2) 11/0's, Button clasp using one needle. Come to the other side and sew into the (2) the (2) Bicones B and the 11/0. Tie the two thread ends together, and burn down ra thread.

Add (1) SuperDuo and sew into the mm, four times. Go through the first o you added. * String (2) 11/0's, (1) 15/0 into the Bicone from the opposite side. 1) 15/0 and sew into the (2) 11/0's you just well as the next SuperDuo. Repeat from * ore times. Step up by going through the ole of the first added SuperDuo.





Step 4: String (1) Bicone 2 mm, (1) 15/0 and sew into the (2) 11/0's from the opposite side. Pick up (1) 15/0 and sew into the Bicone 2 mm as well as the next SuperDuo. Repeat this three more times. Step up by going through the first Bicone 2 mm you added.

Potomac Crystal Bicones 6 mm (A) Approx. 80 pieces

Materials (for up to 8" wrist)

Potomac Crystal Bicones 6 mm (B) Approx. 40 pieces



Miyuki Seed Beads 8/0 Approx. 2 grams Clasp 1 piece

Wildfire Thread .006

Needle size 10

Step 1: This bracelet is made by using the Right Angle Weave (RAW). Thread a needle onto a 5-foot length of beading thread. Add a stop bead, leaving about 3-4 inches tail after the bead. Pick up (4) Bicones A and slide them down to the end of your thread. Sew back into the first (3) Bicones A.



Step 2: From here, you are going to start your pattern. Pick up (2) Bicones B, (1) Bicone A and sew into the Bicone A from the previous unit as well as the next (2) Bicones. Add (2) Bicones A, (1) Bicone B and go through the Bicone B from the previous unit. Sew into the next (2) Bicones you added.



Step 3: Continue repeating Step 2 until you get your desired length of bracelet. Finish the bracelet with (3) Bicones A like on the beginning. To begin the next row, come out through the Bicone A on the top. Pick up (3) Bicones A and sew back into the Bicone A in the first row. Go through the (3) Bicones A you added as well as the Bicone B in the first row.



Step 4: Add (1) Bicone B, (1) Bicone A and sew back into the Bicone A from the previous unit, the Bicone B in the first row and Bicone B you just added. Pick up (2) Bicones A and go through the Bicone B in the first row, the Bicone B from the previous unit, the (2) Bicones A and the next Bicone B in the first row. Continue adding beads the entire length of your bracelet. When you are finished, come out through the Bicone A on the top.



Step 5: Pick up (1) 8/0 and sew into the next Bicone A. Continue adding beads along the sides of your bracelet.



Step 6: To add a Clasp, go through the 8/0, the Bicone A and the 8/0. Pick up (2) 8/0's and go through the Clasp. Sew back into the (2) 8/0's and the 8/0 in the middle from the opposite side. Go through the beads and the Clasp one more time to reinforce it. When you are finished, sew into the Bicone A in the middle row. Add (1) 8/0 and sew into the next Bicone. Repeat this the entire length of the bracelet. When you get to the end, go through the 8/0 and in the same way add other part of the Clasp. Reinforce it and tie off your thread.

Materials for 32" long necklace

Potomac Crystal Bicones 4 mm Approx. 200 Clasp

Potomac Crystal Rondelles 2x3 mm or 3x4 mm Approx. 55 1 piece Wildfire Thread .006

Rondelles 1m Approx. 55 Beading Needle Size 10



Miyuki Seed Beads 15/0 Approx. 4 grams **Step 1:** Thread a needle onto a 6-foot length of beading thread. Add a stop bead to your thread and pass through it two times. Leave about a 6" thread tail. String (4) Bicones, each separated with (3) 15/0's (start with 15/0's and end with a Bicone). Slide the beads down next to the stop bead and sew back into the (3) 15/0's as well as (1) Bicone.



Step 2: Pick up (1) 15/0 and sew into the next Bicone. Continue adding beads the entire way around. Once you are finished, go through the first 15/0 that you added, the Bicone and the first two 15/0's in the set of (3) 15/0's.



Step 3: Add (1) Rondelle, (1) 15/0 and sew back through the Rondelle as well as the middle 15/0 passing through the other side. Go back through the Rondelle and sew into the 15/0 from the bottom towards the top.



Step 4: Pick up (1) 15/0, (1) Bicone, (3) 15/0's, (1) Bicone, (3) 15/0's, (1) Bicone, (3) 15/0's, (1) Bicone, (1) 15/0 and sew back into the first 15/0 as well as the next 15/0 and the Bicone.



Step 5: Repeat Steps 2-3.

Step 6: Continue adding beads by repeating these steps until you have a 32-Inch necklace.

When you get to the end of your design, pass through the Clasp. Sew back into the 15/0, the Rondelle and the 15/0. Reinforce the Clasp by going back through the Rondelle, the 15/0 and the Clasp. Sew back into the 15/0 and the Rondelle. Stitch back into the project, tie a knot and burn down the thread.



Step 7: On the other side, remove the stop bead and thread a needle onto the thread tail. Repeat Step 3, then repeat Step 6 to attach the other end of your Clasp.

Potomac Crystal Bicones 6 mm 19 pieces Wildfire Thread .006

Needle size 12

Czech Glass Pearls 2 mm 29 pieces



Miyuki Seed Beads 11/0 Approx. 1 gram

Step 1: To begin this project, you are going to create Right Angle Weave (RAW) units with two needles.

Thread your needles onto a 5-Foot length of beading thread (one needle on each end). Pick up (3) Bicones and slide them down to the middle of your thread. With one needle pick up (1) Bicone and with the other needle go through the Bicone in the opposite direction. Pull the threads and make sure that you have an equal length of thread on either side. Add (1) Bicone to each needle, then cross the needles through (1) Bicone. With each needle go down through the Bicones on either side.





Step 2: From here, you are going to do the RAW with one needle at a time. Pick up (3) Bicones and sew back through the Bicone from which your thread is coming out. Go through all of the added (3) Bicones. Add (3) Bicones and sew into the horizontal Bicone. Go through the (2) Bicones you just added. Repeat this step on the opposite

side with the other needle.

Step 3: Pick up (1) 11/0 and sew into the Bicone. Add (1) 11/0, go into the next Bicone. Pick up (1)

11/0 and go through the horizontal Bicone. Add (1) 11/0 and sew into the next Bicone. Pick up (1) 11/0 and go through the horizontal Bicone. Repeat this step on the opposite side with the other needle.





With one needle pick up (1) 11/0 and with the other needle pass through this 11/0 in the opposite direction. With each needle pick up (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0 and sew into the Bicone. Repeat from * one more time.

Step 5: With one needle. go down through the adjacent Bicone and out through the horizontal Bicone. Pick up (1) 15/0,

(1) Pearl, (1) 15/0, (1) 11/0, (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0 and pass from left to right through the next horizontal Bicone. Add (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0 and sew into the 11/0. Pick up (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0 and go through the bottom Bicone. Sew into the 11/0, the Bicone, the 11/0, the Bicone, the 11/0 and the top Bicone. Pick up (1) 11/0, stitch down through the Bicone and out through the horizontal Bicone. Add (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0, (1) 11/0, (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0 and sew diagonally through the top Bicone. Pick up (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0 and go through the 11/0. Add (1) 15/0, (1) Pearl, (1) 15/0 and sew into the bottom Bicone.



Step 6: With one of the needles go through the Bicone on the side as well as the 11/0. At this point you are going to embellish the outer edge. Note: If your thread is too short, tie on a new piece.

Pick up (9) 15/0's and sew into the next 11/0. Add (5) 15/0's, (1) 11/0, (3) 15/0's and go through the top Bicone in the middle RAW unit. Pick up (3) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0 you just added. Add (5) 15/0's and go through the 11/0. Pick up (9) 15/0's and sew into the next 11/0. Add (5) 15/0's, (1) Pearl, (1) 11/0, (1) Pearl, (5) 15/0's, skip the 11/0 and go through the next 11/0. Pick up (10) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0. Add (5) 15/0's, (1) 11/0, (5) 15/0's and go through the 11/0. Pick up (10) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0. Add (5) 15/0's, (1) Pearl, (1) 11/0, (1) Pearl, (5) 15/0's, skip the 11/0 and go through the next 11/0.





Step 7: Go through the beads along the edge to reinforce it. Come out in front of the Pearl. Pick up (3) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0 in between the Bicones. Add (3) 15/0's and go through the (5) 15/0's, the 11/0 and the (4) 15/0's. Pick up (4) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0. Go back through the (4) 15/0's you just added. Skip the fifth and the sixth 15/0, go through the next (4) 15/0's and down to the corner. Come out through the (4) 15/0's in the set of (10) 15/0's on the other side. Add (4) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0. Go back through the added (4) 15/0's. Skip the fifth and the sixth 15/0 and go through the next (4) 15/0's as well as the 11/0 and the (5) 15/0's. Pick up (3) 15/0's and sew into the 11/0 in between the Bicones. Add three more 15/0's and go through the (5) 15/0's, the 11/0 and the (4) 15/0's.

Step 8: Pick up (1) Pearl, (1) 11/0, (12) 15/0's and sew back into the 11/0 and the Pearl.

Weave your needle and thread through the project until the threads meet. Tie a square knot on the back of the project. Burn down the extra thread.

Crystal 2 Layer Flower Bracelet

Materials (for up to 8" wrist)

Potomac Crystal Bicones

4 mm (A) Approx. 60 pieces







Potomac Crystal Bicones 4 mm (C) Approx. 40 pieces



Button Clasp 1 piece

Wildfire Thread .006

Beading Needles Size 10



Potomac Crystal Rounds 2 mm Approx. 12 pieces **Step 1:** Thread two needles onto a 6-Foot length of beading thread (one needle on each end). Pick up (1) Button clasp and slide it down to the middle of your thread. Add (2) 11/0's on each needle and drop them down next to the clasp. With both needles go through (1) Bicone B in the same direction.





Step 2: Add (1) Bicone B and (1) 11/0 on each needle. With one needle pick up (1) Bicone A, and with the other needle, go through the same Bicone A in the opposite direction. Add (2) Bicones A on each needle and cross through (1) Bicone A.

Step 3: * Add (1) 11/0, (1) Bicone B, (1) 11/0 on each needle. With one needle, pick up (1) Bicone A, and with the other needle, go through the bead in the opposite direction. Add (2) Bicones A on each needle and cross through (1) Bicone A. Repeat from * to obtain your desired length of the bracelet.



Step 4: Once you are finished, add (1) 11/0 and (1) Bicone B on each needle. With both needles, go through (1) Bicone B in the same direction. Split the needles and pick up (2) 11/0's on each, then pick up (1) 11/0 with both needles. Using one needle, add (28) 11/0's and sew back down through the (1) 11/0 from which the thread is coming out, (2) 11/0's, (1) Bicone B as well as the next Bicone B, (1) 11/0 and out through (1) Bicone A. With the opposite needle, thread through the (28) 11/0's and sew back down through the (1) 11/0, and out through (1) Bicone A. With the opposite needle, thread through the (28) 11/0's and sew back down through the (3) 11/0's, (2) Bicones B as well as the (1) 11/0, and out through (1) Bicone A.



Step 5: At this point you are going to create the top of the flower. * Add (1) Bicone C on each needle. With one needle, pick up (1) Crystal Round 2 mm. With the other needle, go through the (1) Crystal Round 2 mm in the opposite direction. Add (1) Bicone C on each needle and cross through the Bicone A. Go through the existing 11/0, the Bicone B, the 11/0 and the Bicone A on each side. Repeat from * the entire length of the bracelet.



Step 6: Once you reach the end, go through the 11/0, the (2) Bicones B, the (2) 11/0's, and the Button clasp using one needle. Come to the other side and sew into the (2) 11/0's, the (2) Bicones B and the 11/0. Tie the two thread ends together, and burn down the extra thread.

SuperDuo Beads 8 pieces

Potomac Crystal Bicones 4 mm Approx. 34 pieces

Potomac Crystal Bicones 2 mm Approx. 16 pieces

Miyuki Seed Beads 11/0 Approx. 1 gram

Miyuki Seed Beads 15/0 Approx. 2 grams

Wire Guards 2 pieces

Leverback Farwires 2 pieces

Wildfire Thread .006

Needle size 11

Step 1: This project is based on the Tubular Peyote Stitch. Thread a needle onto a $3\frac{1}{2} - 4$ foot length of beading thread. Put on a stop bead, leaving a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch thread tail. Pick up (8) 11/0's and slide them down next to the stop bead. Sew back into the first (6) 11/0's. String (2) 15/0's, skip the 11/0 and sew into the next 11/0, four times. Step up by going through the first (2) 15/0's you added.





Step 2: Pick up (2) 11/0's and sew into the (2) 15/0's, four times. Step up by going through the first (2) 11/0's. Add (1) Bicone 2 mm and sew into the (2) 11/0's, four times. Step up by going through the first added Bicone 2 mm.

Step 3: Add (1) SuperDuo and sew into the Bicone 2 mm, four times. Go through the first SuperDuo you added. * String (2) 11/0's, (1) 15/0 and sew into the Bicone from the opposite side. Pick up (1) 15/0 and sew into the (2) 11/0's you just added as well as the next SuperDuo. Repeat from * three more times. Step up by going through the second hole of the first added SuperDuo.





Step 4: String (1) Bicone 2 mm, (1) 15/0 and sew into the (2) 11/0's from the opposite side. Pick up (1) 15/0 and sew into the Bicone 2 mm as well as the next SuperDuo. Repeat this three more times. Step up by going through the first Bicone 2 mm you added.

Step 5: Pick up (2) 11/0's and sew into the Bicone 2 mm, four times. Step up by going through the first (2) 11/0's. Add (2) 15/0's and sew into the (2) 11/0's, four times. Step up by going through the first added (2) 15/0's.



Step 6: Pick up (1) 11/0 and sew into the (2) 15/0's, four times. Step up by going through the first 11/0. Add (1) 11/0 and sew into the 11/0, four times.





Step 7: From here, you are going to create fringe for each of your (8) 11/0's as well as between each 11/0. * String (8) 15/0's, (1) Bicone 4 mm, (1) 11/0 and sew back into the

Bicone 4 mm, the (8) 15/0's, and the 11/0 your thread is coming out of. Pick up (12) 15/0's, (1) Bicone 4 mm, (1) 11/0 and sew back into the Bicone 4 mm, the (12) 15/0's, the next 11/0. Repeat from * fourteen more times.

When you are finished, go through the (2) 15/0's, the (2) 11/0's, the Bicone 2 mm, the SuperDuo, the (2) 11/0's, the second hole of the SuperDuo, the Bicone 2 mm, the (2) 11/0's, the (2) 15/0's, the 11/0, and the next 11/0. You should be on the top of the earring where you are going to attach an Earwire.

Step 8: Pick up (1) Bicone 4 mm, (1) Wire Guard (go up through the side, over the loop, down the other side). Pinch the Wire Guard a little bit. Sew into the Bicone 4 mm and the fourth 11/0 that sits directly across from it. Reinforce it one more time. Weave the needle and thread through the 11/0's until your thread meets. Take off the stop bead and tie a square knot. Sew into the 11/0, the (2) 15/0's and then burn the extra thread. Attach the Earwire to the Wire Guard.

Repeat Steps 1-8 to make another earring.
