Cleaning Recommendations

Fabrics

To extend the life of your seating upholstered in fabric, regularly dust and vacuum to prevent particles from penetrating the fabric surface.

For light soiling, use a damp cloth and blot the spot with very light pressure. Do not rub the fabric. Dry with clean cloth by blotting - never rub the fabric. For heavy soiling, use the same way, but with a mild detergent. Always test fabric first in an inconspicuous area before cleaning method.

Laminate & painted metal finishes

Wipe the surface with a clean soft damp cloth; if needed, a mild solvent (such as alcohol or liquid) can be used. To prevent streaks, dry the surface with a clean dry cloth in a circular motion.

- **Water-based cleaner (W):** Spot clean, using the foam cleaning agent, such as a mild detergent or non-solvent upholstery shampoo, with a soft brush in a circular motion. Vacuum when dry. Pretest small area.
- **Solvent cleaner (S):** Spot clean, using a mild water-free solvent cleaner only in a well-ventilated room and avoid any product containing acetone or other toxic materials. Pretest a small area before proceeding.
- **Water/solvent cleaner (WS):** Spot clean with a mild solvent cleaner or foam from a mild detergent. When using a solvent or dry cleaning product, use carefully and clean only in a well-ventilated room. Avoid any product containing tetrachloroethylene or other toxic materials. With either method, pretest a small area before proceeding.
- **Vacuum only (X):** Clean this fabric only by vacuuming or light brushing to remove accumulation of dust and grime. Water-based foam cleaning agents can cause excessive shrinking, staining, or distortion of the surface pile and should not be used.
- **Crypton cleaning (C):** Generally stains are removed with detergent. Upholstery foam shampoo, water-based cleaning products, or solvent-based cleaners or dry cleaning products can be used. Be sure to remove all residue from cleaning product. Do not use solvent-based cleaners or dry cleaning products.
- These recommendations and codes were developed by fabric specialists. In various ways fabric can be stained or damaged, there is no guarantee that cleaning will be completely successful. Use suggested methods on your own risk. For heavy soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime, or professional furniture cleaning service when the overall soiled condition is severe.
