## G010 Size Guide

To find your ring and/or bracelet size we recommend using our tape measure. Print out this file on A4. Make sure you print at $100 \%$. This way the tape measure will keep its true size. Cut out the desired tape measure.

## For bracelets:

Wrap the tape measure around your wrist and leave at least one finger in between the tape measure and your wrist to allow for some slack. Mark a point where the tape connects.

## For rings:

Cut out the tape measure for rings. Cut a slit where it says "Cut slit". Wrap the tape measure around your desired finger, and stick the end through the slit. Note down the number.

## Bracelets:

Small: Up to 19 cm
Medium: 19 cm to 21 cm
Large: 21 cm and up

## Rings:

Choose number that the tape indicates

## The ring test:

For accuracy, place a 1 Euro coin on the drawing. It should not over the black dots.


Place 1 Euro coin here

Step 1:
Overlay your existing ring on the circles.

Step 2: Place the ring you already have on top of each circle until you find a perfect match.

Step 3:
The match should fit perfectly on the inside of your ring.

Step 4:
Double check for accuracy.
