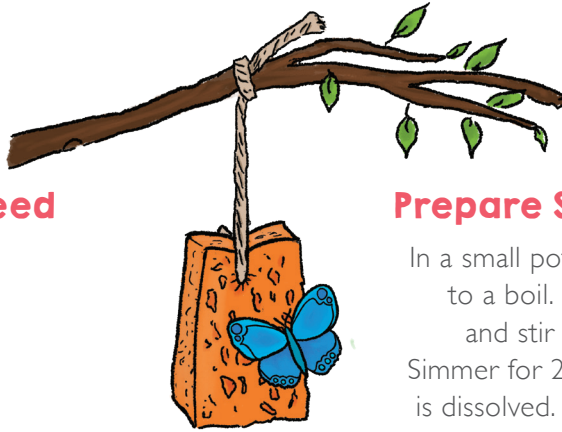


Homemade Butterfly Feeder

Attract beautiful butterflies to your garden or backyard!

Build your feeder and fill it with sweet nectar – a butterfly's favorite food!



What You'll Need

small pot
1 cup water
¼ cup sugar
pencil
sponge
twine

Prepare Sweet Nectar

In a small pot, bring 1 cup water to a boil. Reduce the heat and stir in ¼ cup sugar. Simmer for 2 minutes until sugar is dissolved. Remove from heat; cool completely.

Butterfly Drink Station

Assemble a feeder, dunk it in nectar, and hang it in your garden!

Steps:

- 1 With the help of an adult, use a pencil to poke a small hole at the top of the sponge.
- 2 Thread twine through the hole. Tie the ends together.
- 3 Dip the sponge in sweet nectar syrup until it is fully soaked.
- 4 Dangle the sponge above the syrup, allowing extra syrup to drip off.
- 5 Hang your feeder on a branch, in a garden, or park. Watch for butterflies! They will soon find your feeder and stop for a drink.
