Direct to You: Seaweed and Skincare Insights

The use of seaweed-derived ingredients in skincare products has increased in recent years. This trend is most likely influenced by the many scientific studies that have identified the potential skincare properties of seaweed bioactives.¹ And, that more and more people are showing a preference for products with natural ingredients.²

Seaweeds, also known as macroalgae, are a rich source of various natural bioactive components, including polysaccharides like fucoidan, vitamins like provitamin A, minerals like sodium, proteins, lipids, and polyphenols. These bioactive components have a wide range of biological functions, including antioxidant, anti-inflammatory, antibacterial, and more health-promoting properties that can be used in products like foods, cosmetics, and medicine.

Bioactives are compounds naturally found in nature. They come mainly from plant-based materials like fruits, vegetables, and whole grains. A bioactive compound could be in the form of an oil or an extract from these materials. They basically interact with an organism's living tissues and cells to have a biological effect on them. In a nutshell, it is an interaction between two properties. So, outside of what is grown on land, we also consider what is underneath in the ocean. A special, unique suite of compounds is found in large brown macroalgae, like our laminaria digitata.

7 Fathoms seaweed extract (laminaria digitata) is a highly prized ingredient in skincare formulations for its skin-beneficial properties. Preliminary analysis of 7 Fathoms extract samples for fucoidan indicates that 7 Fathoms extraction process retains this compound at a much higher level than other commercially prepared samples. 
