March's class is an outdoor yard flag, which is totally reversible, and hoopless. It combines machine embroidery and sewing it together to complete the project. The class will be held on Friday, March 27, 2020 from 9 till noon.

**Note:** The **360 x 200 hoop** is used for this project and so only these design formats are available – DST, EXP, HUS, JEF, VIP, VP3 and XXX.

**Please bring mandatory supplies as there are some supplies listed, specifically for this project, in that section.**

You will receive 1 embroidery file, which can be used on other fabrics like nylon or cotton. Obviously there are different options to choose, like stabilizer and scotch guarding the material for outdoor use; including where outside you display it. Therefore, we will be machine embroidering the design on outdoor fabric to eliminate some of those issues.

### **Supplies for this class**

#### **Outdoor Fabric:**

2 – 14 x 24”

#### **No-Show Mesh Stabilizer:**

2 – 14 x 24” **Hint:** Sample used fusible no show mesh so that when you iron your flag, the stabilizer sticks to the back of the fabric.

**Hoop:** 360 x 200

**Mandatory:**

- New embroidery needle
- Assortment of embroidery threads for the yard flag
- Bobbin thread can be neutral
- Owner’s manual for your machine
- Curved embroidery scissors
- Fabric Glue
- Fabric marking pen
- Rotary cutter and ruler
- Fabric scissors
- Wonder Clips
- 1/4” sewing machine foot
- Flag Yard stake to hang finished project.
