## Fabric Requirements

1/3 yard each:

Tonga-B1554 Surf  
Tonga-B1656 Majestic  
Tonga- B1656 Navy

Tonga-B2273 Petunia  
Tonga-B2273 Water  
Tonga-B2500 Dive  
Tonga-B2723 Ocean

Tonga-B2725 Island  
Tonga-B3214 Reef  
Tonga-B7784 Pool  
Tonga-B9230 Hyacinth

Tonga-B9593 Hydrangea

1 1/3 yards Tonga-B2726 Unicorn (sashing and binding)  
3 3/4 yard 45"-wide Tonga of 1 7/8 yards XTonga (106" wide)  
backing of your choice

### Other Supplies

64" x 82" batting  
Creative Grids® 60° Triangle Ruler (8" finished size)  
(#CGRT60)

### Cutting

*From each of the nineteen 1/3-yard Tonga cuts:*

- Cut one 8 1/2" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strip. Using the Creative Grids ruler, cut six triangles from each strip. (figure 1)

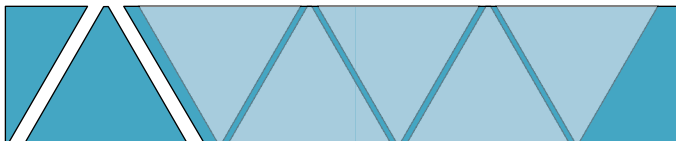

*From Tonga-B2726 Unicorn:*

- Cut seventeen 2 1/2" x WOF strips for sashing and binding.

### Quilt Assembly

1. Working with random color placement, lay out six vertical rows of seventeen triangles each. (*Note: You will have twelve triangles left over for another small project.*)
2. Stitch the triangles together in each vertical row, keeping the preferred color order. Work with one row at a time. Press seams open. (figure 2)
3. Trim the top and bottom triangles with a standard rotary ruler, making sure that you leave a 1/4" seam allowance past the seam joining the end triangles to the strip. (figure 3)
4. Stitch ten sashing strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Press and cut five sashing strips to match the measurement of the vertical triangle rows.

5. Stitch sashing strips between the triangle rows as shown in the quilt photo. Press.

### Finishing

6. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
7. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
8. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

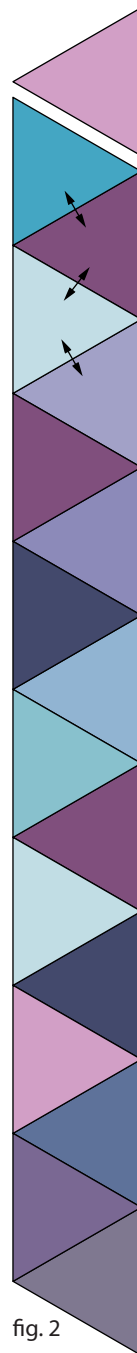

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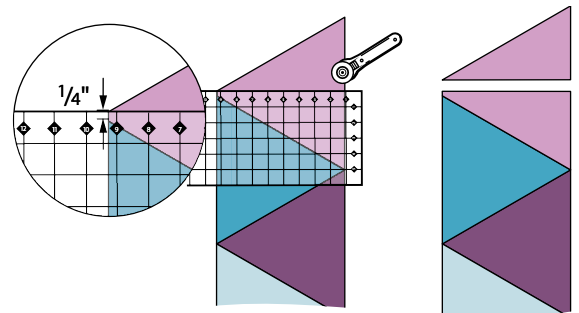
