Sam likes to get in the sand pit. Sam plays in the sand pit with Tim.


This is Kim.




Kim wants to play with Tim and Sam. Kim wants to play in the sand pit.



"Can I get in the sand pit? Can I play with you?"




"You can not get in the sand pit, Kim. You can not fit in with Sam and me. The sand pit is little."



"Sit on the rim.
You can sit on the rim of the sand pit.
You can not get in with Sam and me."

Tim's little rat is on the rim of the sand pit with Kim.



It sits in Tim's hat.
Kim wants to play with it.
"Play with me, little rat."
Kim pats the rat.

Sam's cat gets in the sand pit.
It wants to get the rat.
It likes little rats.



"Play with me, little rat.

I want to play with you."

Tim and Sam do not want the cat to play with the rat.



A cat can not play with a rat!



Kim and the rat get in the sand pit.

Kim plays with the little rat.

Kim and the rat <u>can</u> fit in the sand pit.
