

SAMPLE



My brother, Ben, and I have little tents. Dad's tent is bigger. I can put my tent up without dad's help. A good spot to put up my tent is on the grass in the garden.



My friends like to sleep in my tent with me. We put up the tent and make the beds. I sleep in a red sleeping bag. We put some food in a bag so we can eat when it gets dark.

We get some little sticks and logs to make a fire. Rex gets some sticks as well. Dad lets us have a little fire if my big brother stays with us. We have a hose to put out the fire when we go to sleep.



Ben gets lots of sticks to add to the fire. We do not want the fire to go out. Fires keep bugs out of the tent. We sit in the dark and add lots of sticks to the fire.





My big brother sits with us. When it is dark, he tells us stories. He tells us lots of scary stories. We are not scared. We are too big to be scared by his stories. My brother bets us that we will not stay in the tent after dark. He says that we will get scared when it is dark.



Mum tells my brother to stop scaring us with his stories. She says that we have to go to bed. She says that scary stories will stop us going to sleep. We are not scared of my brother's stories!

My friends and I get into the tent. It is dark in the tent. We get into the sleeping bags. We do not go to sleep. We are not scared and we want to talk in the dark. We tell scary stories, too.


