CHECKLIST OF PARTS INCLUDED: CHAIR TOP FOOTREST WITH FOUR SCREWS & WASHERS SEAT PLATE (ATTACHED TO CHAIRTOP) HYDRAULIC BASE AND PUMP FASTERNER TYPE: EITHER A 6MM HEX KEY, 3/8"

SET YOURSELF UP FOR SUCCESS: INSTALLATION TIPS

- Plan Ahead and Take Your Time Be realistic about the time needed for installation—it will likely take twice as long as you expect. Rushing can lead to mistakes. Set aside a designated receiving area to streamline the process and minimize unnecessary movement. Why? Moving the equipment only once—to its final location—saves time and effort.
- **Handle with Care** Always place the package right side up (follow the arrows and markings on the carton). Move the equipment, while still in the carton, as close to its final location as possible. This reduces the risk of damage during handling.
- **Unpack Thoughtfully** Start by removing the carton top. Pause and read the handling instructions before unpacking further. This small step could save you thousands of dollars in potential damage.
- Check for All Parts Before moving the equipment, count the loose parts against the checklist provided. If you can't find a part, don't discard the packaging just yet. Check inside the foam wrapping and other hidden spots. Use the checklist to confirm if something is truly missing. If needed, call us at 888-827-2889 for guidance—we're here to help.
- Follow the Assembly Instructions -Your equipment is mostly pre-assembled, but it's important to read the assembly instructions. If you're unsure about any step, don't hesitate to call us at 888-827-2889 for assistance.
- Avoid Dragging the Equipment Never drag the equipment, as it can cause damage, and the manufacturer is not liable for mishandling. If the equipment is too heavy to lift, use a suitable dolly and enlist as many people as needed to move it safely. When removing it from the dolly, handle it with care to avoid accidents.



ATTACH THE FOOTREST

Place the chair upside down on the cardboard box or a non-abrasive surface to protect it. Align the footrest with the pre-drilled holes at the front of the chair. Use the fastener to loosely thread the screw with the washer, until all four screws are secure. Tighten them evenly. Once secure, flip the chair upright and ensure the footrest is stable.

ATTACH THE CHAIR TOP TO BASE

The seat plate, located on the underside of the chair top, connects the chair to the pump. Align the pump's pin with the hole in the seat plate, then gently press the chair top down until the pin locks securely into place. Check underneath to ensure the pin is fully inserted and the connection is stable.

TEST THE CHAIR

Ensure the treadle is not fully raised, then tap it slightly downward to check its movement. With someone seated, spin the chair in a full circle several times to test smooth rotation. Finally, pump the chair to its maximum height and lower it back down, repeating this process three times to ensure proper height adjustment.
