BOOKING

- Please book via our website – this is the best way to secure your spot!
- A \$10 non-refundable booking fee applies, which also covers the guide and equipment hire.
- Bookings are available up to 3 weeks in advance.
- Walk-in's are accepted but we can't guarantee availability. The \$10 charge still applies.
- Bookings are available between 9am and 2pm on weekends and public holidays, and 10am to 2pm during the week.
- Book for the number of salmon you want to catch, not number of people in your group.

WHAT TO DO/BRING

- Please arrive 5-10 minutes before your booked time. Let the cafe staff know you are here for Catch-A-Fish
- Bring friends/family! They can watch from the picnic area.
- Bring some warm clothes and a jacket in case of bad weather.

RULES

- You must purchase what you catch – there is no "catch and release".
- The price per kg is \$35.00 (from August 1, 2023).
- Size range of salmon in the pen will be displayed in the cafe (2.0kg – 5.0kg). If you catch a salmon bigger than 5.0kg, you can swap it for a smaller one.
- You can't bring your own rod for biosecurity reasons.
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult (lifejackets available).
- Once a salmon has been caught and landed, our staff will remove the salmon from the hook and kill the fish for you. The salmon will then be weighed.
- Our staff will clean (gill and gut) your salmon and take it to the cafe for pickup and payment.
- Filleting and vacuum-packing is available for \$10 per fish.
- Complimentary packaging with ice and paper. \$10 for packaging in box with ice (stays cold for 48 hrs)

OTHER INFORMATION

- No experience is necessary!
- No gear required.
- Suitable for all ages.
- Disabled access available.
- There may be extra rules in place due to the Covid Protection Framework.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Follow the instructions from the High Country Salmon staff at all times.
- Lifejackets are available - please ask if you want one for yourself or your child.
- Eye protection is available and recommended.
- Children 12 and under must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Please don't enter the water at any stage.
- Be aware of uneven surfaces.
- Be careful with the fish hooks as they are sharp!
- Once you have landed a fish, alert the staff and they will remove it from the hook for you.
