## HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Before printing, be sure to check that this guide is set to print at $100 \%$ scale and that you are printing on standard A4 paper ( $216 \mathrm{~mm} \times 279 \mathrm{~mm}$ ). If you're not sure if you've printed the right size, or if you're measuring on a computer screen, place a credit card on top of the guide below.

## OPTION 1

After you cut out the ruler, cut along the dotted line to create an opening. Wrap the ruler around your finger so that you can see the numbers. The number that appears closest to the opening of the ruler is your ring size. Try moving the ruler across your knuckle. You'll want to choose a size that moves easily on and off your finger. Please note that ring sizes may vary slightly according to the style.

## OPTION 2

The easiest way to determine your ring size is by using a existing ring. Match the inside of the ring to one of the circles below. You should only be able to see the black circle within your ring, with little or no white paper showing.
