Typical paint tester pots are wasteful and usually not recyclable. People buy loads of them, and they knock around in draws or go straight to landfill. So we changed the game with COAT Peel & Stick Swatches, and 95% less waste.

Any conscious business thinks hard about single-use plastics, and our Swatches are the pack leader when it comes to practical and responsible choices:



- 95% less waste than a conventional 200ml tester pot (our swatches use 10ml of paint)
- √ 100% Adhesive free (no solvents)
- √ 100% Recyclable PET material

Planet Friendly Supplies

Plastic paint brushes are the cheapest and most widely available option. But like tester pots, they're usually non-recyclable virgin plastic and destined for landfill. Not good enough. COAT has partnered with the only B-Corp certified provider in Europe for our high-grade eco-friendly painting supplies:



- ✓ Paint Brushes infinitely farm-able bamboo handles, 60% re-used and 100% fully recyclable metal and bristles, made in the UK
- ✓ Paint Roller frames infinitely farm-able bamboo handles,
 60% re-used and 100% fully recyclable metal
- ✓ Paint Roller sleeves 100% recyclable when used with water-based paints like COAT
- Paint Tray made from sugarcane bagasse, a natural waste material that's biodegradable and compostable







Smart Deliveries

It's boring, but so important. We delivery paint directly to home, which is more efficient and direct with less wasteful travel. Think less lorries, and less back-and-forth trips to DIY stores. Entirely recycled or recyclable packaging too. It's a crticial shift.

- Cardboard packaging is unbleached and 100% recyclable
- Recycled steel paint tins are infinitely recyclable





- Protective shipping bags are 100% natural cotton and fairly-traded
- Protective shipping moulds are 100% recycled and recyclable
- Kraft paper packaging tape is 100% recyclable and vinyl-free
- ✓ Wooden stir sticks are FSC certified








Beyond Carbon Neutral


COAT has been 100% Carbon Neutral since day one.

360 Degree Recycling

2 million litres of excess paint is sent to landfill every year in the UK. 50% of it is probably in your shed or understairs cupboard, am I right?

Any COAT customer can send back their empty tins or unused paint, and we'll process them fully for recycling. That means the tins, handles, and most importantly any excess paint is recycled.

We work with a partner who process excess or waste paint and turn it into their own recycled paint product - so there's nothing going to waste.

There's even more being done by COAT when it comes to minimising paint waste, which we're pretty excited about.
