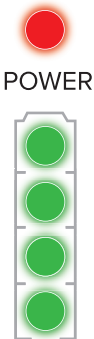

CHARGING INFORMATION



RED LIGHT ON CHARGER:
CHARGER IS POWERED UP AND READY TO CHARGE THE BATTERY

GREEN LIGHTS ON CHARGER:
GREEN LIGHTS DISPLAY HOW FULL THE BATTERY IS.
WHEN THE BATTERY IS FULLY CHARGED ALL 4 GREEN LIGHTS WILL BE ILLUMINATED

WARRANTY INFORMATION

As your PowerBug Lithium battery and charger has been purchased from PowerBug directly, there is no need to carry out warranty registration.

Battery and warranty information has been safely stored on the PowerBug database.

Simply retaining your proof of purchase (Either electronic or a printed copy) is sufficient documentation should you ever need to make a warranty claim

GENERAL INFORMATION

All PowerBug battery products are made of the best quality components offering safe, stable and long lasting battery solutions. This provides ease of use and charge/recharge cycles that will deliver power for years to come.

To achieve the best from your battery please follow these instructions.

- Always charge your battery as soon as possible after your round of golf.
- Ensure the charger / trolley connections are fully engaged into the battery.
- Check to ensure that there is no debris in the charger / battery plug or socket.
- Once the charger light switches from red to green the battery is fully charged - to preserve the life of the charger it is best to disconnect the charger once the green light illuminates.
- When you disconnect the charger ensure that the charger is disconnected from the mains and the battery.
- The battery will remain in perfect condition after charging for at least 12 weeks so no top up charging is required.
- When the charger is connected to the mains and not the battery a green light should show.
- When the charger is plugged into the battery the red light will be seen, if not you are not charging. Once the red light is on you can leave the charger and battery to work together.
- Do not position the charger in a way that will cause any strain on the cabling or connections.
- Always charge batteries in a cool well ventilated and safe environment away from any inflammable materials.
- Never use a battery or charger that shows signs of damage or degradation.
- Use of this product should be restricted to persons of appropriate age and ability.
