Sewing Machine with a quarter inch foot and accessories

One piece of Template Plastic (3" by 12" piece)

12" Add-A-Quarter ruler

Purple Thang

6" X 12" ruler

Medium size cutting mat (18" X 24")

New rotary blade

Size 70/10 Microtex sewing machine needles

Scissors

Seam Ripper (a quilter's best friend... sometimes)

Surge protectors

Extension Cords

Fabric Glue or glue pen (Fons and Porter, Sewline, or Avery recommended)

High Quality cotton sewing thread
Flower pins
Scotch tape
Large Ziploc bags (2 gallon is best or 1 gallon)
Stapler
Binder clips, medium
Large paper clips

Small iron

Pre-Class Instructions:

Pre-cutting the fabrics is a ***mandatory*** requirement prior to taking this class. ***Please begin preparing*** for class at least 2-3 WEEKS prior to the class to make sure that you are able to get familiar with your pattern and complete the pre-cutting before hand. It is important that you have your pre-class cutting completed. If this step is not completed, you will have a very difficult time keeping up and participating in the instruction.

First READ through the entire pattern before beginning.

Foundation Papers and Template Sheets:

Please refer to and follow the instructions under ***'Foundation Papers, Templates, and Template Layout Sheets'*** on page 1 of your pattern, and ***'Setting up your Bags #1-3'*** on page 2 of your pattern.

Cutting Instructions:

Please read through 'General Information' on page 1 of your pattern before completing the steps below. We recommend checking our website for pattern corrections before you begin

cutting your fabric. **Note: Please make sure all of the Template Sheets, Foundation Sheets, and fabric pieces are placed in the correct bags!**

Cutting Instructions, Bag #1, Center Spikes:

Follow the steps under ‘Cutting Instructions, Bag #1, Center Spikes’ on page 2 of your pattern. **Note: Do not follow the steps that involve cutting through the Template Layout Sheets as Jackie will go over this in class! Place fabric pieces in the specified bag.**

Cutting Instructions, Bag #2, Unit M:

Follow the steps under ‘Cutting Instructions, Bag #2, Unit M’ on page 3 of your pattern. **Note: Do not follow the steps that involve cutting through the Template Layout Sheets as Jackie will go over this in class! Place fabric pieces in the specified bag.**

Cutting Instructions, Bag #3, Background Border:

Follow the steps under ‘Cutting Instructions, Bag #3, Background Border’ on page 3 of your pattern. **Note: Do not follow the steps that involve cutting through the Template Layout Sheets as Jackie will go over this in class! Place fabric pieces in the specified bag.**
