The following items will be used in class:

***Splash of Color: A Rainbow of Brilliant Black-and-White Quilts
by Jackie Kunkel***

- Sewing Machine with a quarter-inch foot and accessories
- Iron
- Ironing Board/Mat
- Template Plastic
- 6" x 12" ruler
- Add a Quarter ruler
- Medium size cutting mat (18" x 24")
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm
- New rotary blade
- Size 70/10 microtex needles
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Surge protectors
- Extension cords
- Glue Pen (Fons & Porter, Sewline or Avery)
- High quality cotton sewing thread 50 weight preferable.
- Pins
- Foundation paper (Carol Doak's Newsprint)

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Fabric:

Yardage based on 42" wide fabric:

3 yards of white print for block backgrounds
1 5/8 yards of red print for blocks
1 3/8 yards of orange print for blocks
1 1/4 yards of yellow print for blocks
1 1/8 yards of green print for blocks
7/8 yard of white and black print for border
3/4 yard of black print for border and binding
3/4 yard of blue print for blocks
5/8 yard of indigo print for blocks
1/2 yard of violet print for blocks
1/4 yard of hot pink print for blocks
4 1/4 yards of fabric for backing
73" x 73" piece of batting

Cutting Instructions:

Please follow the cutting instructions on page 51 and 53 of the book *Splash of color*, prior to coming to class. **Tip:** Organize each "section" or color from your cutting into its own Ziploc bag to keep in order.

Foundation Paper Printing:

Make 128 copies of the foundation pattern A on page 57. Cut out the foundations, leaving about 1/8" of paper all around the outer line.
