

BENEFITS OF CARTONBOARD RECYCLING

What are the benefits of cardboard recycling?

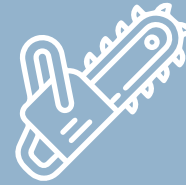
Cardboard recycling yields fibres that can be made into new cardboard products.

A recent study by Graz University estimates that fibre-based packaging material can be recycled at least 25 times.



Saves on valuable resources

1 tonne of recycled cardboard can save up to 17 trees from being cut down.

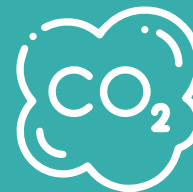


Saves energy use and energy costs from creating new cardboard from wood.



Significantly reduces carbon emissions

that would otherwise be produced from converting new trees into new sheets; unnecessarily cutting down trees to make products that can otherwise be made with recycled board



Reduces the volume of waste sent to landfill.

Cardboard is one of the most efficient materials to recycle. Every ton of recycled cardboard saves approx. 6.9m³ [9yd³] of landfill space. This equates to at least around 1.32 tonnes of carbon. Diverting waste from landfill also helps to prevent other negative impacts of landfill such as air and water pollution.
