SR2 & SR1 funds: SR1 was from covid Cares act and SR2 is similar and we have broad discretion for use of funds to continue to provide services. SR3 is similar but 20% must be used on learning recovery (after school, summer school, etc). 21-22 budget draft does not yet include any changes to lease for the remodel. Fund balance policy requires that if our balance falls below 20%, we have to approve the budget by majority and declare a temporary emergency on the balance.
