

## 2023-2024 Classroom Supplies List



New City School's learning environment promotes cooperation and community-building, and we therefore encourage shared-use of many classroom materials (especially in K-6 classrooms). Please purchase the following items for your child(ren) as requested by their teachers below. **Please DO NOT label** shareable materials with your child's name (pencils, crayons, glue, etc.).

### **\$20 contribution to support classrooms**

To cover the additional costs of classroom materials throughout the school year, we ask that every family bring \$20 per child to their child's Crew leader on Back to School Night (Aug. 23) or within the first week of school at the latest. This year, all classrooms in K-8 will facilitate their own community snack program, asking families to contribute snack on a rotating basis that follows specific nutritional guidelines.

If you are a parent of multiple students remember each student has their own class supply list and we ask that you provide items and contributions for each child. As always, if you would like to contribute more money to support other children you are welcome to do so. *Classroom contributions (cash or check made out to New City School) and supplies for grades K-8 should be turned into your child's Crew leader on Back to School Night (Aug. 23<sup>rd</sup>)*

### **Snack in grades K-8**

Every student needs to have full access to healthy foods and snack throughout the day — this is true for our youngest kindergarteners up to our oldest 8<sup>th</sup> graders. Each grade level runs their own snack program that relies on community contributions. You will soon be hearing from your child's teacher about their community snack program and how you can contribute. Thanks for helping to fuel the brains of our growing citizens!

### **Healthy Snack Guidelines**

- Contain 200 calories or less per serving
- Include less than 2 grams of saturated fat
- Include zero (0) grams of trans fat
- Contain less than 200mg of sodium per serving
- Include zero (0) grams of added sugars
- Have a whole grain, fruit, or vegetable listed first in the ingredient list

1 box 24 count #2 pencils (community supplies)  
1 pkg Large pink eraser (community supplies)  
Black, chisel tip, Expo dry-erase markers (community supplies)  
1 pkg of 2-3 glue sticks (community supplies)  
1 container disinfectant wipes (community supplies)  
1 box tissues (community supplies)  
2 regular sized, spiral bound notebooks (personal supplies)

**Grades 7-8**

Students in grades 7 & 8 should keep their school supplies in their backpacks and/or lockers for use throughout the school year and should not turn them into their Crew leaders. Only the \$20 for additional school supplies should be turned into Crew leaders on Back to School Night (Aug. 25<sup>th</sup>).

NCS provides a locker, lock, and planner for every student in grades 5-8<sup>th</sup> grades. Students are not allowed to use non-school issued locks on their lockers.
