Our leathers are biodegradable, naturally died and metal free. No chemicals were used during its tanning process so they can present discolorations or organic imperfections that mustn't be considered flaws.

All our shoes are individually made and finished by hand and, as a result, each pair may differ slightly from the next, making your Lusquinos pair one of a kind.

LEATHER AND SUEDE CARE

Leathers age naturally with time and wear and must be well taken care of to guarantee its natural durability.

LEATHER

Use a slightly wet wipe to clean the leather and finish it with a dry cloth to complete the process. Being 100% biodegradable, our leather is not waterproof, therefore wet and damp environments must be avoided. In case your Lusquinos, make sure to dry your shoes out, away from aggressive heat sources or direct strong sunlight

SUEDE

In addition to using the cloth process above for leather we are including together with your biodegradable shoes a piece of latex, from leftovers during production of our crepe soles. You can use it to clean your suede uppers. All you need to do is rub the suede with it and it will look clean and nice again.

CREPE SOLES

Crepe soles tend to lose their initial cream color over time and tend to darken and change as you wear them. In order to keep them clean you can use a wet cloth with traditional pink soap and clean the sole all around and it will look nice and clean.

Please do not forget that all our components are totally organic so any color change should be considered as part of the product's natural evolution.
