

Care & Cleaning Instructions

HAND TUFTED RUGS

- Slight variations may occur in each rug as these are all woven by hand.
- Shedding is normal process with rugs and happens when it's first brought home & gradually fades away. It usually takes 3-6 months to have the rug settle in.
- Using a rug pad extends the wear and life of your rug. This adds a layer of cushioning and keeps your rug in place.
- Rotate or reposition the rug every three or six months to enable even wear & tear.
- To store, roll the rug with front side in and wrap with a clean cloth for protection. Do not fold or put in an airtight plastic bag.
- Do not soak or wash the rug in any liquid.
- Do not dry clean. Occasional professional cleaning, if necessary. Advise cleaners not to soak or wash the rug in any liquid. For larger, deeper stains, cleaning agents should be used in moderation.
- Avoid use of harsh chemicals for removal of stains.
- Light vacuum regularly with suction only.
- Do not pull loose or protruding ends; neatly clip with a pair of scissors.
- Remove spills immediately. If liquid, blot with a clean undyed cloth by pressing firmly around the spill to absorb as much as possible, and the rug should be dried on both front & back sides.



STORAGE

- All of our storage products are made from 100% heavyweight cotton canvas, which is naturally durable and stain resistant.
- Because the natural fibers will absorb moisture, nothing wet or damp should be left in them.
- Do not machine wash!
- If needed, we recommend that you spot clean as needed with a clean dry cloth.
- If the stain persists, hand wash the affected area only with a clean, slightly damp cloth, with natural detergent if needed.
- To get your storage perfectly perfect, iron the inner sides with high steam.

CLOTHING

- Machine wash cold, tumble dry low, do not bleach, warm iron if needed.
- As all of our clothing is made from 100% organic cotton, some shrinkage may occur.

BEDDING, QUILTS, HODED TOWELS, PLAY MATS & PILLOWS

- Machine wash cold on a gentle cycle with natural detergent, and tumble dry on low heat.
- We recommend any items with pom poms and/or tassels to be washed in a laundry bag.
