



CARE & CLEANING

- Slight variations may occur in each rug as these are all woven by hand.
- Shedding is normal process with rugs and happens when it's first brought home & gradually fades away. It usually takes 3-6 months to have the rug settle in.
- Using a rug pad extends the wear and life of your rug. This adds a layer of cushioning and keeps your rug in place.
- Rotate or reposition the rug every three or six months to enable even wear & tear.
- To store, roll the rug with front side in and wrap with a clean cloth for protection. Do not fold or put in an airtight plastic bag.
- Do not soak or wash the rug in any liquid.
- Do not dry clean. Occasional professional cleaning, if necessary. Advise cleaners not to soak or wash the rug in any liquid. For larger, deeper stains, cleaning agents should be used in moderation.
- Avoid use of harsh chemicals for removal of stains.
- Light vacuum regularly with suction only.
- Do not pull loose or protruding ends; neatly clip with a pair of scissors.
- Remove spills immediately. If liquid, blot with a clean undyed cloth by pressing firmly around the spill to absorb as much as possible, and the rug should be dried on both front & back sides.
