Notes:

- Soil Testing should be carried out to start the season. Any pH issues or nutrient deficiencies can then be rectified during the Spring Lawn Renovation. You can purchase a [DIY Soil Test Kit](#) or you can get a full analysis with recommendations done via LCA. - You should aim to irrigate your lawn with 25mm of water each week in growing season. If you undertake a Spring Lawn Renovation, you may need to switch to shallow watering, more often to aid in recovery.
- Timing of the Grub Prevention and Pre-emergent Herbicide can also change to coincide with your Spring Lawn Renovation. You just don't want to leave it until too late in October as you would have missed the window for Summer weed germination.

Notes:

- If using Plant Growth Regulator (PGR), this should be applied every 3-4 weeks in season depending on local temperatures. For best results, tank mix with Stressbuster to reduce any yellowing. PGR should only be applied to turf with full coverage.
- You should aim to irrigate your lawn with 25mm of water each week in growing season. If you have particularly hot weather, you can increase the watering. Likewise, if you get some rain, you can back off your watering over those periods.

Notes:

- If using Plant Growth Regulator (PGR), this should be applied every 3-4 weeks in season depending on local temperatures. For best results, tank mix with Stressbuster to reduce any yellowing. PGR should only be applied to turf with full coverage.

Pre-emergent Herbicide may need to be applied earlier if you are in a part of Australia where temperatures drop sooner than other regions.

Pre-emergent Herbicides can also be tank mixed with TriSmart.

Notes:

- Winter water requirements are far less than what your lawn required in growing season. You can get away with one watering per fortnight. Be sure to water in the early morning to avoid encouraging fungal disease.
