The <u>Koala Eco Multi-Purpose Kitchen Cleaner</u> is made with plant-based, biodegradable ingredients, including Australian lemon myrtle and mandarin essential oils. I've been hesitant when it comes to using multi-purpose cleaners on certain kitchen surfaces, like the inside of the microwave, because of the overwhelming chemical scents that linger (or, worse, attach to foods), but the Koala Eco cleaner disinfects *and* deodorizes without synthetic fragrances and chemicals.
