2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: No significant risk but may be a mild irritant to people with sensitive skin.
Other hazards: Spillages on floors are a slip - hazard if walked upon.

3. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: No symptoms expected.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES
