

## **BR48236 B-1B Early Exhausts** With Turkey Feathers

Designed for the 1/48th scale Revell B-1B Lancer kit. Fitted on early production B-1Bs.


This set contains 4 complete early exhausts with turkey feathers. Buffeting of the turkey feathers in flight led to buckling and tearing. and some parts actually tore off in flight, leading to the order for them to be removed sometime in the 1990s.


- 1) Carefully saw mold blocks from exhaust tube and exhaust nozzle. Clean up rear faces by block sanding to assure that they are flat. Clean up key slots and tabs and test fit the components to make sure they assemble properly.
- 2) Test fit the exhaust nozzles to the kit. Some trimming of the rear openings of the kit nacelles might be necessary to get them to fit.
- 3) Do not assemble the parts yet. This is a good point to paint all the parts. I would highly recommend googling GE F-101 afterburner and studying the images for color and finish of the components.
- 4) Assemble exhaust units after painting using Cyanoacrylate or 5 minute epoxy and install during final assembly. Enjoy!
