Bf 109G Tailplanes w Separate Elevators

Designed for the 1/48 Tamiya
109G kits.

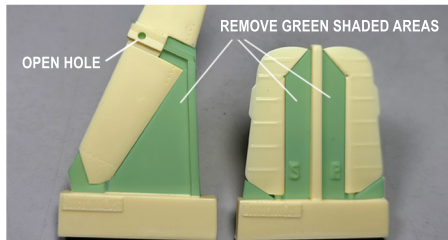
This set consists of a replacement horizontal stabilizer with separate elevators, as the 109 is almost always seen on the ground with the elevators drooping from gravity. These resin parts directly replace the kit parts. It's a quick and easy installation

- 1) Begin by removing the casting block by careful sawing. Cut away the thinner support material by gentle, repeated scribing, then carefully breaking away. Clean up with files and sandpaper..
- 2) Drill open the hole on the centerline of the horizontal tail, using a file to enlarge the hole, test fitting the kit vertical fin until pin fits snugly into the hole. Test fit the horizontal tail to the assembled fuselage. It should fit exactly as the kit part does.
- 3) Clean up the elevators. Note they are marked as P for port and S for starboard. Test fit and adjust. Assemble parts with Cyanoacrylate.
- 4) Assemble rest of model per instructions. Check out our other sets for the Tamiya Bf 109G-6, and 5 wheel sets and decals for the Bf 109G-6 in 1/48 scale, too!
