



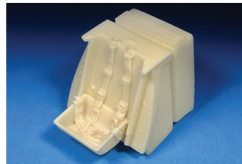
BR48370 Bf 109G/K Seat with Belts - Tamiya

Designed for the 1/48 Tamiya
109G-6 kit. May be adapted
to fit other kits.

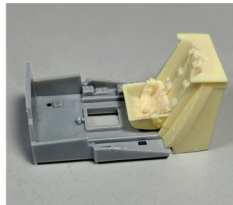
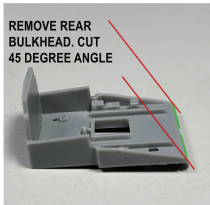
This set consists of a simple one-piece casting to replace the kit rear cockpit bulkhead and seat pan, to save you the trouble of fighting with photoetch seatbelts. This seat features a complete detailed harness molded in high relief for ease of painting.

- 1) Begin by removing the casting block by careful sawing. Saw in from all sides. On kit part B23, make a 45 degree saw cut at the cockpit rear bulkhead to floor junction. Clean up cut line.
- 2) Test fit rear bulkhead to the kit floor. Assemble with Cyanoacrylate. Test fit floor and rear bulkhead assembly in the assembled fuselage exactly as you would the kit part. Adjust if needed.
- 3) Paint cockpit sub assemblies as normal. Cockpit is painted overall RLM 66, a dark grey color. The belts are a light tan color, and the tapered lap pads are sometimes khaki or olive green. Buckles and hardware on the belts are dull silver. A thin black wash applied to the belts will pop out the buckles and other details.
- 4) Assemble rest of model per instructions. Check out our other sets for this Tamiya Bf-109G-6 kit.
