



BR72213 BAC Lightning Mk 4 Ejection Seats

Designed for 1/72 Airfix new tool Lightnings. May be made to fit all other Lightning kits.

This set contains a pair of super detailed resin Martin Baker Mk. 4BSA ejection seats with molded in harnesses & separate upper and lower ejection handles.

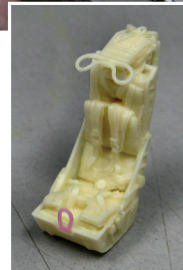
- 1) Break rear casting rib away with pliers. Cut sprue into two parts. Carefully remove the ejection seat by carefully sawing in from both sides. Clean up bottom face by block sanding. Test fit to model and adjust if necessary.
- 2) Carefully clean out any residual flash from ejection handle loops with the tip of a hobby knife. Paint handles while still on sprue. Base: Red. Loops: Yellow with black spiral stripe.
- 3) Paint seat according to reference photo in instructions. Remove ejection handles by carefully scoring with a knife. Attach handles as shown with CA (Suerglue) or white glue.
- 4) Install finished seat during final assembly with CA or white glue (PVA) as per kit directions. Enjoy.
